NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS

Notice is hereby given that the City of Sandy, Clackamas County, Oregon, will receive sealed proposals in the office of the City Recorder of the City of Sandy up to eight o'clock P. M., on Monday, the 26th day of August, 1946, for the construction of a municipal sewer system and sewage treatment plant, which said sealed proposals will then and there be opened and publicly read, allowed and considered. Bids received after the time of opening will not be considered.

The sanitary sewer system will consist of the following main items: 2760 L.F. of 12-inch sewer pipe, 15,300 L.F. of 8-inch sewer pipe, 3402 L.F. of 6-inch sewer pipe, 51 concrete manholes. Excavation and back-fill of 11,400 cubic yards in trenches. Alternate bids for both concrete and vitrified clay pipe will be received and considered.

The sewage treatment plant will include two alternate plans of design.

The pre-qualification of bidders will be required in accordance with Sec. 98-102 to 98-106 O. C. L. A., inclusive.

Proposal forms, specifications and plans may be examined in the office of the City Recorder and at the office of the Engineer, H. L. Gilbert, 406 Governor Building, Portland 4, Oregon. A set of specifications, bidding blanks and plans may be obtained at the office of the engineer upon depositing \$25.00. The full amount of the deposit will be refunded on return of plans and specifications in good condition within ten days after date of bid opening.

Each bid must be accompanied by a certified check, Cashier's check or bid bond with an accepted surety company as surety, made payable to the City of Sandy in an amount equal to five (5%) per cent of the total amount of bid.

The City of Sandy reserves the right to reject any or all bids, and to accept or reject any alternate bids, also to make an award for the sewer system and treatment plant to separate bidders, and to waive informalities.

No bidder may withdraw his bid after the time set for the bid opening or before award of contract unless such award is delayed for a period of more than thirty days.

State of Oregon, County of Clackamas, City of Sandy, ss: I, the undersigned Mayor of the City of Sandy, Oregon, do hereby proclaim that at the special city election duly called and held in said City on the 22nd day of July, 1946, at which there was submitted to the legal voters of said City for their adoption or rejection a proposed charter amendment, the ballot title of which was as follows, to-wit:

AN ACT
To amend the Charter of the City of Sandy as adopted by the legal voters of said City of Sandy at a special election held November 14, 1913, together with subsequent amendments thereto, and to amend all other amendments thereto enacted by the legislative assembly or by vote of the people, by adding thereto Chapter XVI, providing for an issue of not to exceed \$24,000.00 bonds of said City for the purpose of providing funds to construct a trunk line leading to a sanitary treatment plant, and to construct a sanitary treatment plant.

There were cast 135 votes as follows:

In favor of said charter amendment 127 votes;

Against said proposed charter amendment 7 votes;

Votes spoiled and not counted, 1;

Majority in favor of said proposed charter amendment 119 votes.

And I do hereby further proclaim that the foregoing charter amendment was duly adopted by said voters at said election.

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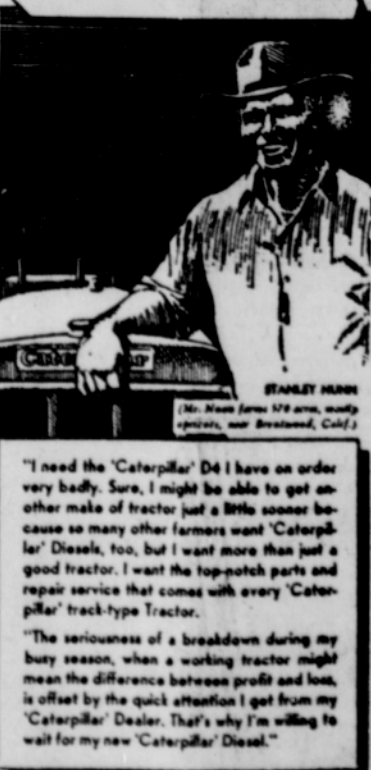
