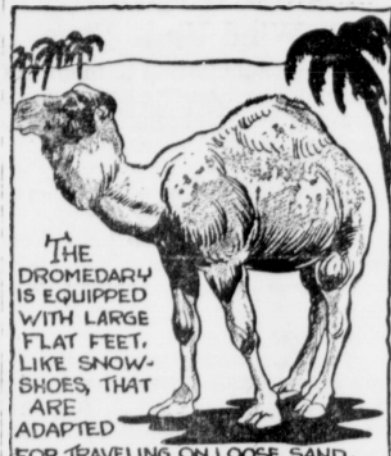
At a business meeting following the pot luck dinner President Lorraine Martin announced that club members had sold \$133 worth of tickets to the recent show for the Sandy Memorial
