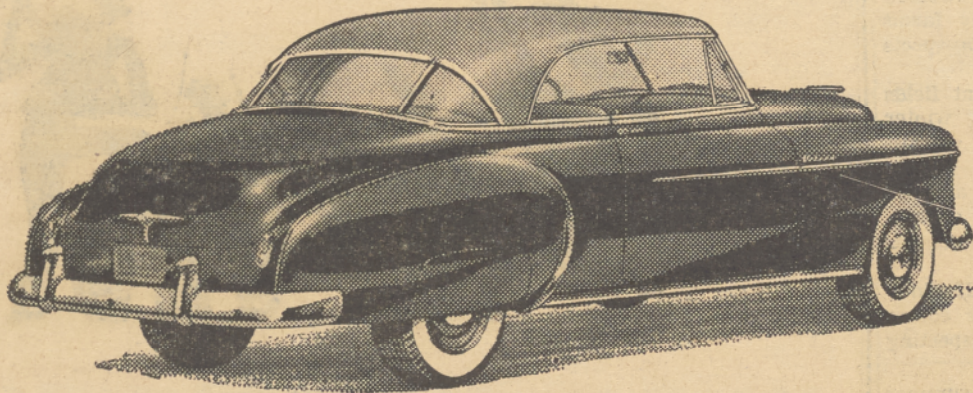

Scholarships In Navy To Be Given

SEATTLE—The Navy Department has announced that 160 competitive examination scholarships to the U. S. Naval Academy will be granted again this year to members of the civilian reserve of the Navy and Marine corps.

These scholarships entitle successful candidates to a full four year expense paid course of instruction at the academy plus pay, uniforms and travel. Upon graduation, members will be commissioned in the U. S. Navy or Marine Corps.

To be eligible to compete in the examination certain requirements must be met. The candidate must be in good health, a U. S. citizen, a member of the Naval or Marine Corps Reserve on June 30, 1950, unmarried and not over 21 years of age on April 18, 1951.

Those desiring to compete may obtain detailed information from the nearest Navy or Marine Corps Recruiting office, or by addressing Headquarters, Thirteenth Naval District, Seattle.

Donors From Two States Answer Emergency Call

OREGON CITY, May 26—Ten A-B positive blood donors answered an emergency radio appeal Thursday noon, issued by the Clackamas County chapter of the American Red Cross. A West Linn resident, seriously ill in the Good Samaritan hospital, needed four additional pints of blood to be used as needed.

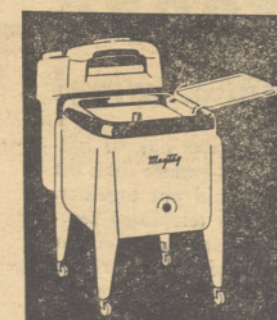
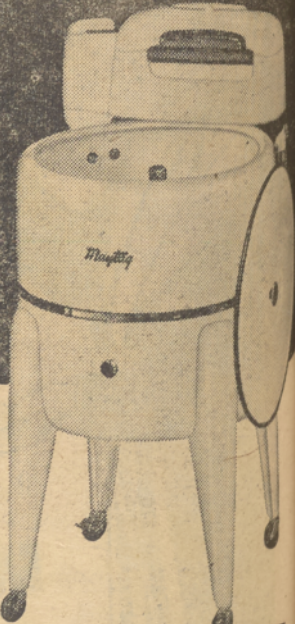
