Rains Mean Added Bait For Strawberry Weevil

Strawberry root weevil are emerging from the soil as adults, making it necessary to bait fields for control of this insect pest, states Leon Garolan, county extension agent. Bait applied before rains may have lost their effectiveness, making re-baiting necessary. Adult weevil begin laying eggs within two weeks after emerging, thus the reason for having bait in fields at all times once emergence has begun. During day time, adults will be seen hiding underneath old leaves and clods. Weevil are considered one of the most serious insect pests of strawberries, with some growers estimating annual losses from 25 to 50 per cent of the crop, Garolan adds.
