Circus Is Sold On Auction Block To Clear Taxes

OREGON CITY — The circus that was scheduled to come to Sandy early this summer was sold last week to pay off an \$11,000 tax lien filed by the federal government. The circus has been bogged down near Oregon City since the night before its scheduled appearance in Sandy.

The Clackamas County sheriff's office was the agent used by the federal government to close the circus. Monkeys, elephants, lions, a kangaroo, horses, ponies and bears, and a fleet of trucks and automobiles and other equipment sold for \$7800.

Buyer was the son of the late Norman Anderson, original owner of the circus. Mr. Anderson has been operating the circus since his father's death as a menagerie.

The claim of the government was founded on alleged delinquency in submitting admission taxes.

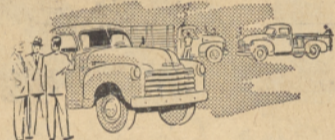

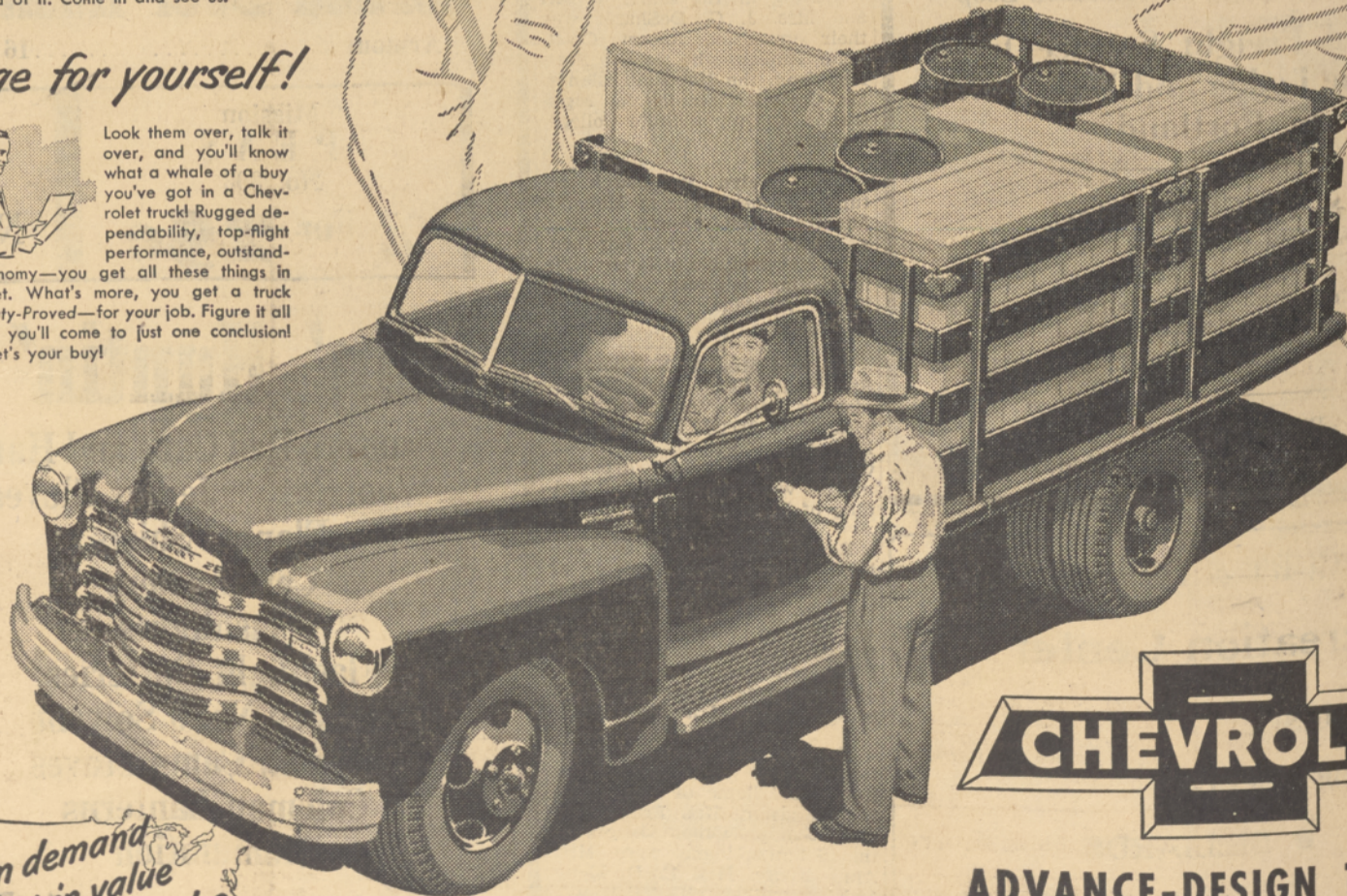
