Don Coin Walrod Reports On County's DHIA High Milk Producing Herds

Six of Clackamas county's DHIA herds produced an average of 40 or more pounds of butterfat for the month of November according to reports submitted by DHIA testers L. C. Berney, Richard Gale, and Jim Howard, says Don Coin Walrod, county extension agent.
Owners of these high producing herds are Edwin Ridder, Wilsonville, 43.8 pounds; Rudolph Luscher, Rosemont, 43.5 pounds; Dr. J. B. Harrison, Eagle Creek, 45.9 pounds; Frank E. Meier, Oregon City, 40.3 pounds; and Mrs. A. Vanderbeck, Marquam, 47.4 pounds. Fall months are difficult to hold production, as indicated by the small number of herds qualifying, says Walrod, and these owners are to be congratulated.

Top Cow
Top producing cow to finish a lactation during the month of October was No. 17, a registered Guernsey cow owned by Josi Bros., Oregon City. In 305 days No. 17 produced 11,333 pounds of milk containing 732.9 pounds of butterfat. Her age was seven years and one month. This cow will probably be near the top of the list for high producing cows of the year. Next in line for October was McLily, a registered Brown Swiss cow owned by Meier Dairy Farm, Boring. McLily produced 12,608 pounds of milk containing 600.7 pounds of butterfat in 305 days at four years and seven months of age.

64 On Honor Roll
Sixty-four other cows qualified for the state honor roll for the month by completing lactation which totalled more than a certain set amount of butterfat according to the age of the cow. Starting November 1 these requirements are being increased to the following amounts: two year olds must produce 400 pounds of butterfat; three year olds 450 pounds; four year olds 500 pounds; and five year olds and over 550 pounds of butterfat in 305 days or less.

25 High Producers Named
Twenty-five individual cows distinguished themselves by producing 75 or more pounds of butterfat in the 31 days of October. These high producers are: Rosie, a registered Brown Swiss owned by Meier Dairy Farm, Boring, with 75.6 pounds of butterfat; Charm and White Back, registered Holstein cows owned by Dr. J. B. Harrison, Eagle Creek, with 93.1 and 87.9 pounds respectively; Babe, a registered Jersey owned by Rex Ross, Mt. Angel, with 75.5 pounds; Tippy, a Holstein cow owned by Lawrence Douthitt, Monitor, with 81.7 pounds; May and Hazel, registered Jersey cows owned by Mrs. A. Vanderbeck, Marquam, with 91.3 and 85.1 pounds respectively; Favor, a registered
