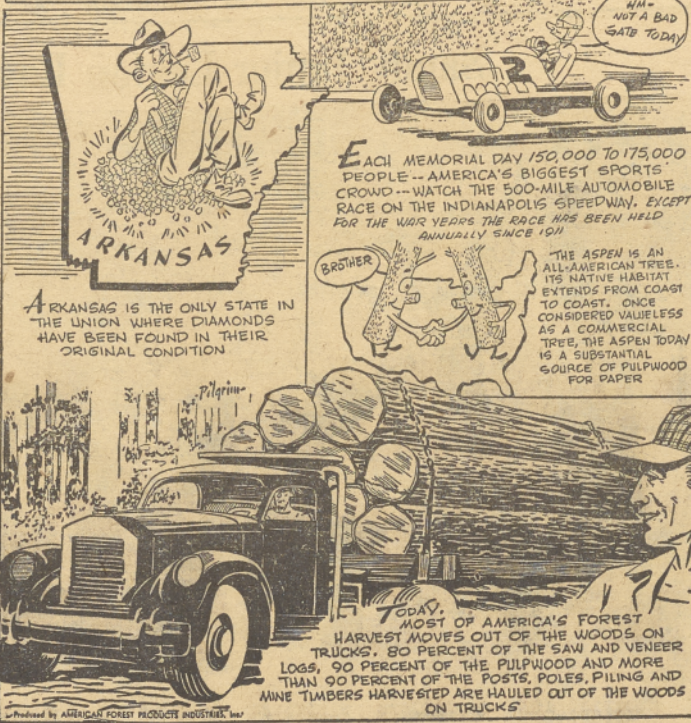
The couple will make their home in Hood River where Mr. Newman is employed by Union Pacific railroad.
