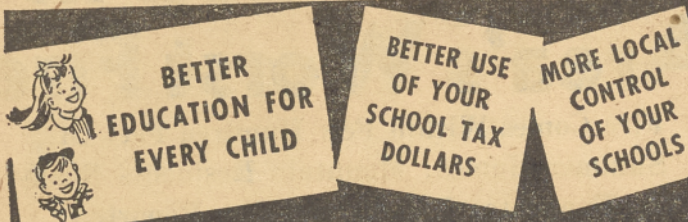

The program was in charge of Mrs. E. W. Cook, lecturer.

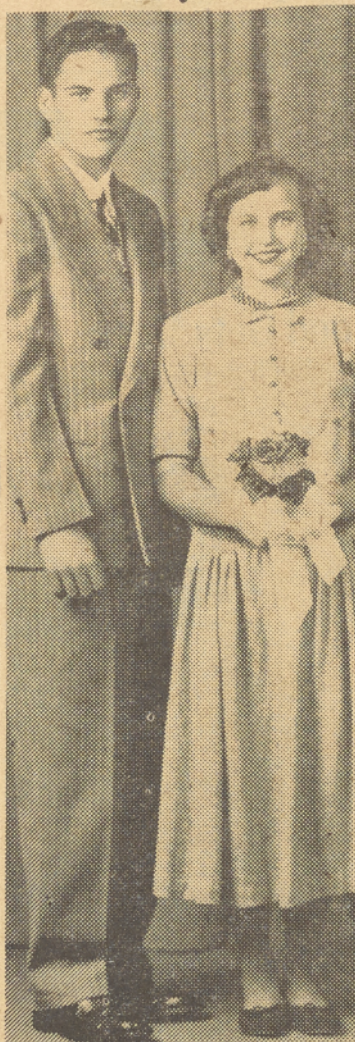
Sandwiches, salad, cake, jello and coffee were served at the close of the meeting.
