

Anderson To Assist Filbert Growers To Market Produce

Effective October 1, 1952, Mr. H. E. Anderson, a filbert grower from the Sunnyside District, was appointed by the Filbert Control board as field

representative for the board.

He will be contacting growers who market their own filberts for the purpose of assisting them in preparing their filberts that they might conform with the State and Federal laws.

Mr. Anderson will also be contacting and checking for com-

pliance both wholesale and retail outlets within the State of Oregon, since filberts to be marketed in the shell have to meet certain legal standards.

Since all first buyers of filberts are required to contribute to the research program undertaken by the Oregon Filbert Commission, Mr. Anderson will also be checking with the first buyers.

Operating And Equipment Loans Offered By FHA

Full-time family type farm operators who desire to make adjustments for more efficient and profitable farming may apply to Farmers Home Administration for farm operating and equipment loans. All loans are based on a sound farm management plan.

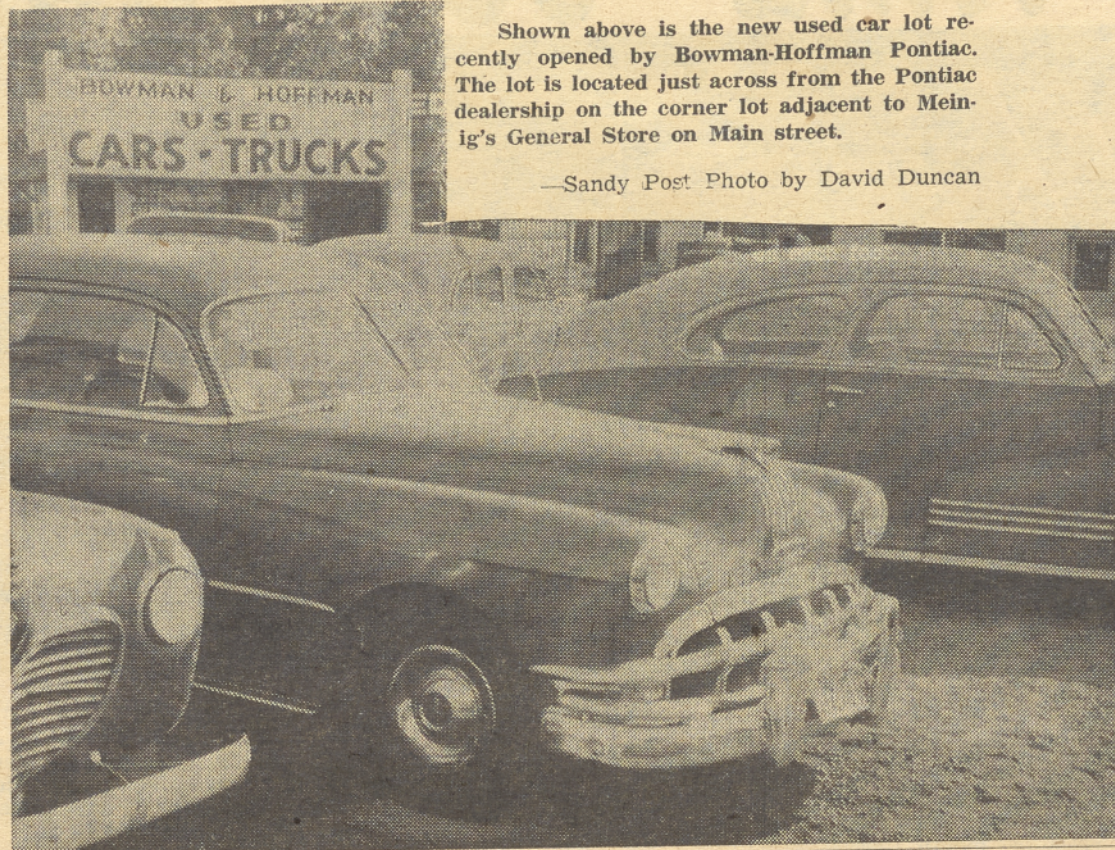
Operating and equipment loans may be made in amounts not to exceed \$7000.00 in one fiscal year or a gross limit of \$10,000.00. Rate of interest is 5% and repayment up to seven years.

The Farmers Home Administration also maintains the Water Facilities program which offers credit to qualified farmers for the purchase and installation of domestic and irrigation systems on family farms.

A. J. Deggendorfer, County Supervisor, states it is not intended that the Farmers Home Administration operate in competition with private credit. Hence only those family farmers who are unable to obtain satisfactory credit from private sources are eligible.

The office of the Farmers Home Administration is located in the Chamber of Commerce Building, 9th & Super Highway in Oregon City and services Clackamas, Hood River and

A brother, Technical Sergeant Duane Eliason, is stationed in the United States Air Force at Elgin, Florida Air Force Base.

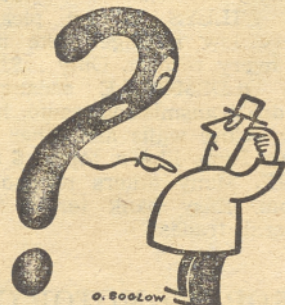
