

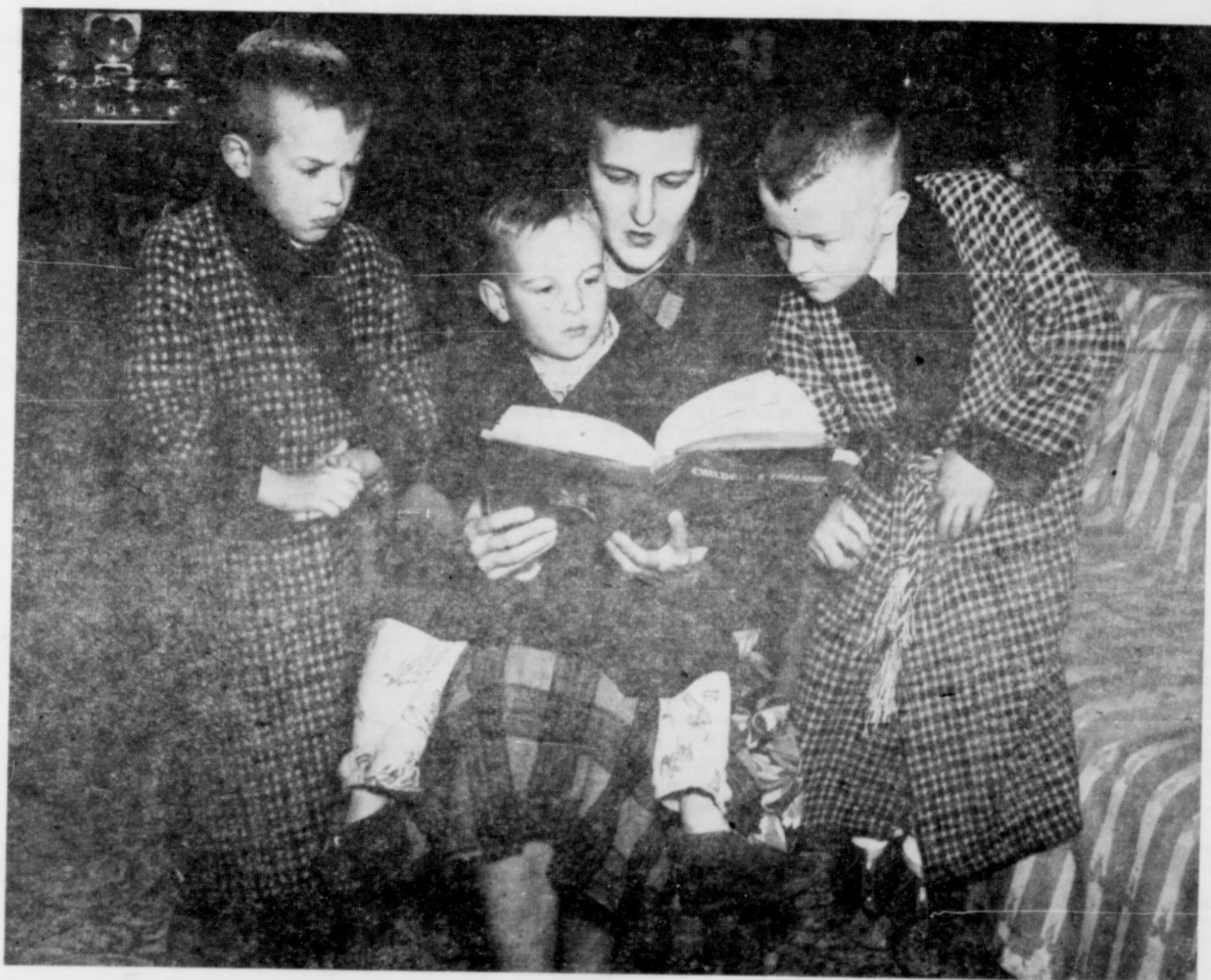
Easter's For The Young . . . And For The Home
