County Weed Control Officer Urges Cooperation In Program

County Weed Control Officer Sandy—The success or failure of the Clackamas County's program for the control of noxious weeds will be determined to a great extent on the cooperation of the citizens of the County. The County can enforce

compliance with the State law requiring eradication of noxious weeds and as a matter of fact, it is doing so at the present time. However, we feel that once you are aware of the seriousness of this situation you will not wait to be forced into compliance, but will want to do all you can to protect the crops of your neighbors. Even those of us who live in a rural area but are not actively engaged in farming do not want to create a problem for our neighbors whose income depends upon their crops.

Under the County's present eradication program we are meeting with cooperation and success through the County through the desires of the property owners to rid themselves of undesirable weeds. However, there are always a few property owners who are reluctant to cooperate through lack of understanding of the overall program. As I have said before, I am authorized to compel property owners to rid their property of noxious weeds. It is not the intention of the County Court or myself to cause any undue hardship, and if you need assistance

or advice with your weed problems, feel free to call the County Weed Control Officer at my home, MOhawk 5-5784.

A number of serious infestations have been reported during recent years on County property. O & C timber lands and on properties held by the utilities companies. The county is receiving 100 per cent cooperation in the eradication of noxious weeds on these properties and the county itself is cleaning up the weeds on county held land.

Since this program depends on cooperation from all property owners, we are asking that you give us assistance in our program by eliminating the noxious weeds located on your land. We are reasonably certain that under this cooperative arrangement these weeds will soon be eliminated throughout the County.

Spraying is being done at a terrific rate. We are short of licensed sprayers and equipment. Some new ones are coming out now and probably we will get along OK. If you are in need of a sprayer, please con-

tact me at the aforementioned numbers and I will send you a list of the spraymen available. You can take your choice from the list. They all charge the same. These men have all proven to be dependable and in the event one is proven otherwise, we will remove his name from the list. They all charge the list.

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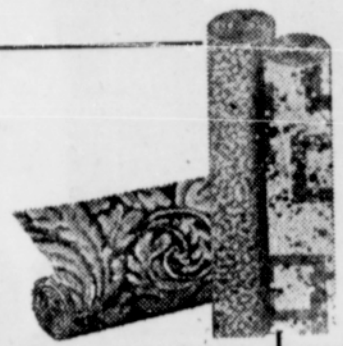
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
