TB And Mental Hospital Patients Get Yule Gifts From County Donors

OREGON CITY — Christmas gifts for patients in the tuberculosis and mental hospitals were dispatched from the Clackamas County Tuberculosis and Health association the past week and returns were tabulated for the 49th annual Christmas seal sale being conducted through December to raise funds to finance the work of the organization.

Ten men whose ages ranged from 42 to 81 years received from the association a gift each of pajamas, a shirt, slippers or toilet articles. Six women from 25 to 73 years received a gift each of pajamas, slippers, a pen or a painting-craft set.

An eight year old boy received a toy truck to haul toy produce on his bed-side table. The youngster whose tuberculosis is moderately advanced, is from an Indian migrant-worker family that has already lost one child because of the disease.

Gifts for the mental patients were brought to the TB association's office by organizations within the county, whose members had contributed the gifts and were picked up there by workers from the Mental Health association of Oregon, sponsors of the project.

Total Christmas seal returns of \$12,567.39 were reported by Mrs. Georgia Farmer, executive secretary, for the fourth week of the TB seal sale.
