## On Human Rights

The seventh anniversary of the adoption of the Universal Declaration of Human Rights, is an excellent time to remind ourselves, rather sadly, of the distance the world has yet to go in the attainment of those rights.

Yet to go? That isn't quite the right phrase. It implies we have come some distance already. We haven't. Seven years of discussion have hardly defined what human rights are. We haven't begun to work out a practical approach to attaining them. The attitude of Soviet Russia makes it increasingly doubtful that we can or will.

But this isn't a season for despair. It is the time when the world remembers the birth of the Prince of Peace who, after all really made clear what basic rights humans have. For it was his apostle, Paul, who spoke down through the years to all of us to stand fast in the liberty with which Christ made us free. 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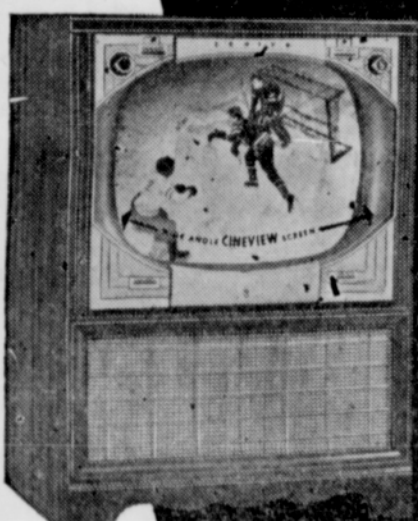
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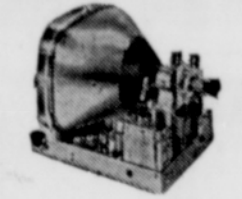

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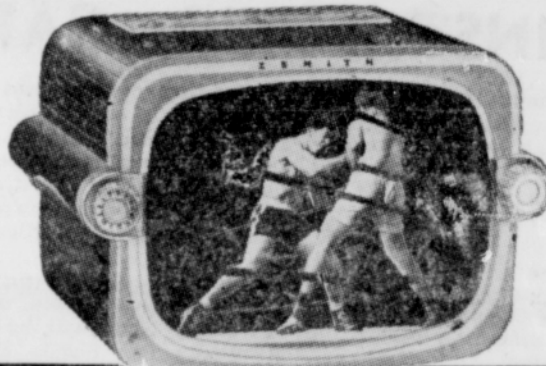
