Social Security

Through your Social Security Administration, the following information is offered through a question and answer series on everyday questions on Social Security.

Q: Does being "fully insured" mean that I will receive maximum payments when I retire?

A: No. Being fully insured merely guarantees that you or your

survivors will receive benefits—not necessarily the maximum. All benefits paid under social security are based on your average monthly wage during the computation period. To receive the maximum benefit your average monthly wage must be \$350. For further information on this point I would suggest writing or calling the nearest social security office
