Your Social Security

Q: I was told all I needed was 18 months or 6 quarters as a farmer to be covered for Social Security. How come I had to pay self-employment on the full year which makes 8 quarters?

A: Any person engaged in a business (i.e. farming) must pay taxes based upon his years operation, either calendar or fiscal. The year is not to be less than 12 months unless ended by death or by permission of the Internal Revenue service. A word of caution, you will still have to pay self-employment taxes every year in which you clear \$400.

Q: How long must I work to qualify for benefits at age 62?

A: If you become 62 after 1970, you will need 10 years (40 quarters) to be insured. If you become 62 before that time you will need fewer quarters depending on your date of birth. Contact your nearest office, or request Social Security pamphlet OASI-35 for specific information on this point.

Q: Can male workers draw Social Security benefits before age 65?

A: No. The only benefits a male can collect before 65 is the disability benefit if he can qualify. Payments at age 62 are for the working woman and the wife of the retired worker.

Q: My disability was denied when I filed last November. I'm still not able to work and need financial help. Is there any way to change the decision about it?

A: Your claim can be reconsidered. You should keep in mind the fact that your denial was based upon the evidence you submitted with your original claim. Inasmuch as that material was not sufficient to permit finding you disabled, you should have something additional and material in support of your claim for reconsideration.

Q: I understand that I'll be referred to a vocational rehabilitation agency if I file for disability benefits. What is its purpose?

A: The primary purpose of the agency is to provide you with rehabilitation services that will help you prepare for and find suitable work. You are referred to them by the Social Security Office to determine your work capacity; whether rehabilitation services can help you, and what kind of services would be most useful to you. If you refuse to accept these services without good cause, your benefits must be withheld.

Q: I am disabled, but never worked under Social Security. I received a payment in 1951 when my husband died. I'm 58 now. Can I draw disability benefits under this new law?

A: No. Disability payments are made only to the worker who is disabled and is 50 years of age or older. However, you will be entitled to receive widows benefits at age 62.

Q: My husband owned and operated a cleaning shop from 1940 until June 1954. He became permanently disabled at that time. He is 58 now. Can he receive disability benefits from his social security?

A: One of the requirements is that he work under social security for at least 5 out of the last 10 years immediately before he became disabled. Since your husband's work was not covered by social security until 1951, he would have only four years which we could consider. He would not be eligible for payments.

Q: My wife is 63 but refuses to file a claim for benefits. Can I file for her?

A: Unless she is unable to handle her own funds because of a mental or physical reason, she must file her own claim. Her decision not to file may be well founded if she is aware of the basis for actuarial reduction. There are many factors to consider before filing while under 65, for example, health, life span, income etc.

Q: I am a laundress. I work for three different employers, one day each week in each home. Should each employer deduct social security tax?

A: Yes. If each employer pays you \$50 in cash wages in a calendar quarter, he should be paying social security tax.
