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ADD RATES

Two cents a word. Minimum Classifieds under one dollar. charge 50 cents. Billing or credit 25 cents extra. Classifieds containing larger type are charged on the basis of 90 cents an inch. Church bazaars, suppers, bake sales and other community events will be run under special announcement classification. Card of thanks, minimum rate \$1.00.

The holder of a subscriber ad card is entitled to one free ad. You may include one or more items in an ad. We will classify it under the proper heading. You are entitled to write as much as you wish on one side of each card. Do not use ad card for sale of real estate auction or business cards—all of which must be paid for as classified ads. If you buy merchandise specially for resale or operate a service business (garage or hatchery) such ads are paid anything you raise or produce, classified. Rental ads, sales of household goods, originally bought for your own use, help wanted, personals—all are eligible to become subscriber ads for the holders of subscriber ad cards. Write your full name, mail distance from nearest town or route, box number, direction and crossroad clearly on the card. Include the phone number if you have one. If near a grange hall, school or other landmark, it is a good idea to include the information.

Subscriber ads are always printed in the first issue after receipt. Ads received before 10 AM Tuesday will be in the Thursday paper. If you wish an ad repeated you can elicit it out, paste on another card and mail or bring it to the Sandy or Estacada offices. Only one identical ad will be accepted for a single issue—duplicates will be discarded.

Don't forget, you can buy as well as sell with subscriber ad cards. Let the seller look you up. Often the person with the best buy doesn't think about selling until he reads your ad.

A: No. Since you are totally and permanently disabled and have been granted a "freeze", the amount you may receive beginning no earlier than July, 1957, will be the same as you will receive upon attaining age 65.

Disability benefits must be reduced by the amount of any other disability benefit payable by a Federal agency or under a State or Federal workman's compensation law or plan. At age 65, the benefit is not so reduced.
