We all like a cake that can be stirred up in a jiffy but yet one that is very tasty. Here is just the type of cake that is a blessing to the busy housewife: 2 cups dried prunes or apricots 1 cup boiling water 2 cups sifted flour 1 1/2 cups sugar 1 teaspoon salt 1 1/4 teaspoons soda 1 teaspoon each of cinnamon, nutmeg and cloves 1/2 cup cooking oil or shortening 3 eggs unbeaten 1 cup chopped nuts (omit if desired)

Pour boiling water over prunes let stand two hours. Sift dry ingredients into large mixing bowl. Add prune mixture, oil, eggs and nuts. Blend thoroughly about one minute. Beat two minutes at medium speed or 300 strokes by hand.

Pour into a greased and floured loaf pan 13 X 9 1/2 inches. Sprinkle batter with streusel topping, 1/2 cup sugar, 2 tablespoons flour and 2 tablespoons soft butter mixed until crumbly. Bake in a 350 degree oven for 45 to 50 minutes. Cut in squares and serve warm or bake batter in paper-lined muffin pans. Can be served in wedges with caramel sauce or vanilla ice cream.

A good tip for this week is to use the electric mixer to begin making a meat loaf. This makes a meat loaf of a finer grain.

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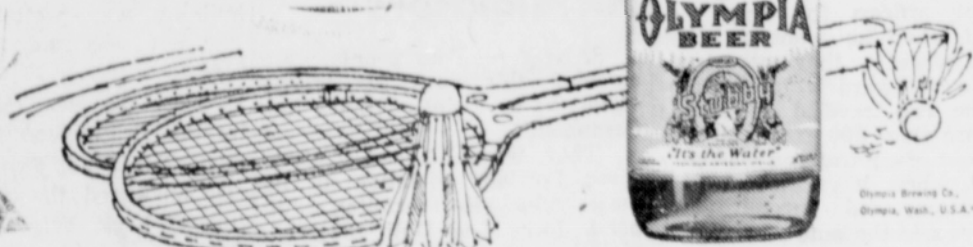
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
