The speaker, a recent religious convert, was formerly an associate of the notorious Al Capone, well-known underworld character and gambler.

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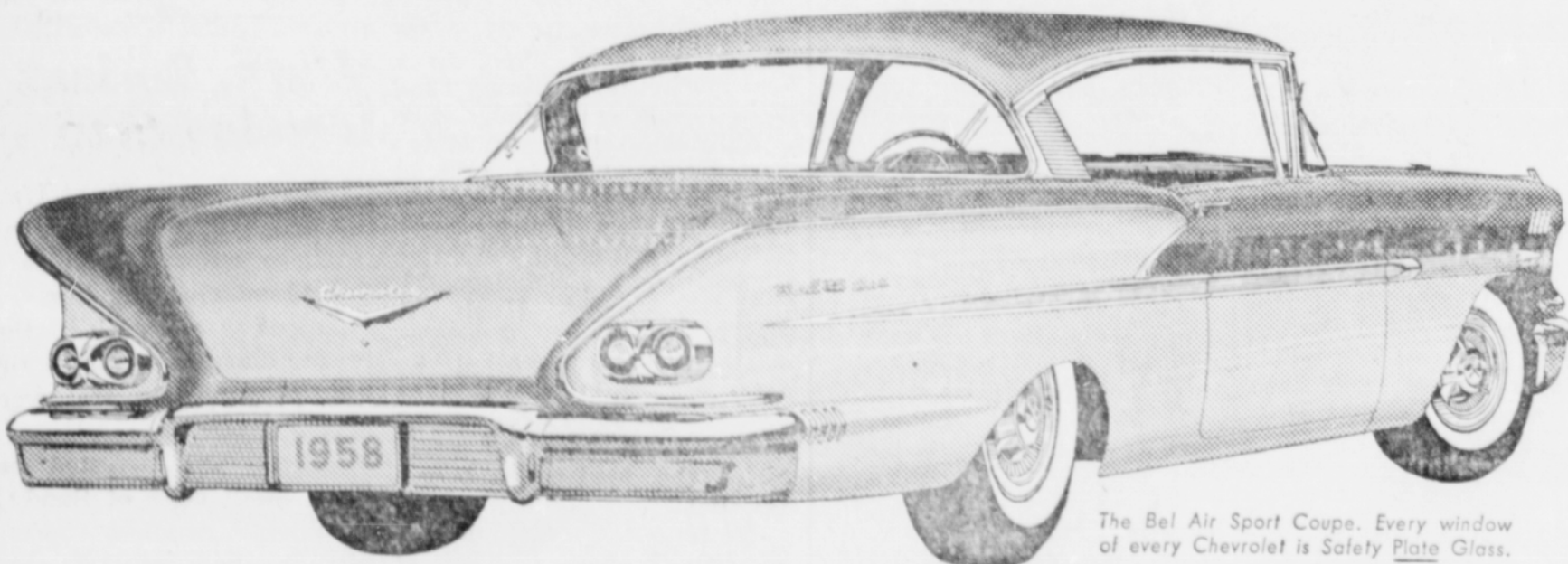
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
