At this time the legal voters residing in the City of Sandy, Oregon, will vote on a Charter amendment. Full copies of said proposed Charter amendment is found in a copy of the Resolution attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof, and the original Resolution containing the same is a part of the minutes of the Council Meeting of August 11, 1958, which minutes are hereby referred to and by reference made a part hereof.

The following is the Ballot Title, the number and form in which the question will be printed on the official Ballot: **CHARTER AMENDMENT SUBMITTED TO THE VOTERS BY THE COMMON COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANDY, OREGON:**

Purpose: To add to the Charter of the City of Sandy, Oregon, Chapter XX which provides for the acquisition of additional real property from which additional water may be obtained for use of the said City; to improve, construct or replace the reservoir at the present intake of water for the use of the City of Sandy; to extend and provide for the construction or replacement of the water line or lines within and without the City limits of the said City of Sandy; for the construction of an extension to the sewer system of said City within the City Limits thereof; authorizing issuance of Sixty Thousand (\$60,000.00) Dollars in bonds to finance the cost; guaranteeing principal and interest thereon from ad valorem taxes on all the real property within the corporate limits of the City of Sandy, Oregon. **SHALL THE AMENDMENT BE ADOPTED?**
