

**ARAB HORSE SHOW**

SALEM--Clackamas county horses and their owners will be represented when the Arabian Horse Breeders Association of Oregon and the Shrine Club Patrol of Al Kader Temple stage their 13th annual All-Arabian Horse show at the state fairgrounds here June 20-21.

Celebrated as the oldest single-breed show on the Pacific Coast, the event is dedicated to the world's only

pure strain of horse which dates back nearly 400 years. Known as the basic stock for nearly every popular breed of horse today, Arabian are easily recognized by their delicately heads, graceful bodies, stamina and a versatility unrivalled in the horse world.

While the show here will attract exhibitors and their mounts from all over the country, Clackamas county residents including three from Molalla, Mrs. Dorothy K. Magill, William Maness and Rey

Purpose of Oregon Arabian show is to give exhibitors and breeders a chance to show off their animals and to give the public a chance to see this oldest of all horses demonstrate his beauty and ability. 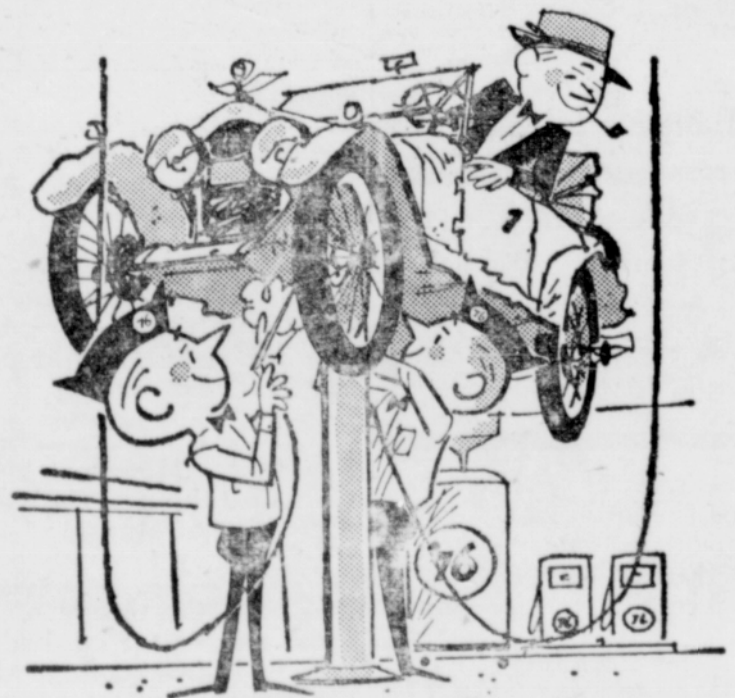
