GOAL SET

PORTLAND — Goal for the United Good Neighbor campaign this fadd has been set t \$3,276,287 by the Multnomah county United Funds, which last week added United Cerebral palsy to its membership. The goal is 6.3 per cent more than the \$3,082,027 raised in the 1958 campaign for 71 community agencies.

The United Funds last week announced they would campaign under a new name, United Good Neighbors, as a prelude to possible eventual merger of the three separate organizations.

The three boards accepted \$3,276,287 as the UGN goal on recommendation of a tri-county committee composed of representatives of each of the three United Funds.

Inclusion of United Cerebral Palsy in United Good Neighbors brings the number of agencies and services supported by UGN to 72 and eliminates Cerebral Palsy's independent spring appeal to the public for funds.

UGN's newest agency serves victims of cerebral palsy through a workshop program, psychological counseling and assisting in purchase of braces, wheelchairs and other equipment.

Harold M. Phillips, tri-county committee chairman, and Multnomah county's UF president, expressed confidence that the goal can be reached this year.

He cited a healthy economic climate, peak employment and favorable business conditions as indicators for a successful campaign.

"The tri-county committee believes this is a reasonable and attainable goal. It represents a minimum need in the light of a growing population. Particularly in the numbers of children and youth, increased costs and greater demand for UGN services," Phillips said.

The UGN goal is the amount needed to operate the 72 agencies and services during 1960. The 6.3 per cent goal increase compares with 9.5 per cent increase in Seattle, 25 per cent in Chicago, 7.9 per cent in Cincinnati, 14 per cent in Worcester, Mass., 6.7 per cent in Houston, Texas and 5.2 per cent in Pittsburgh.

Total UGN agency requests amounted to \$3,750,581. A 100 man budget committee headed budget requests from each of the member agencies for 1960.

This analysis, results of the agencies and consideration of economic and other factors were used in determination of the UGN goal.

YOUR SOCIAL SECURITY

Question: About two months ago I hired a woman to come in three times a week to clean my house and do the laundry as I have not been well. She keeps telling me I should pay social security tax on her, but I didn't think it

was necessary on housework. Can you advise me?

Answer: If you pay her more than \$50 in a calendar quarter, social security tax must be paid. You will need an Employer's Identification Number and tax returns for reporting the tax. These may be obtained from the bureau collects the tax or through your local social security office.

Question: I operate a farm and have heard that the reportable wages must now be at least \$1500. Is this true? Answer: Any cash wages of \$150 or more for farm work must be reported; or, if the same employee works for you on 20 or more days and is paid by the hour, day, or other time basis, such wages must be reported. This is true regardless of the amount of such wages.

Question: I have heard that I should know what I can expect from social security for myself and my dependents. place to go for specific information?

Answer: The best place is your nearest social security district office. The folks in your social security office will to answer any questions you may have and they have available free booklet for distribution. They also will show you how you can check your social security earnings record to find out if its correct.
