

NOTICE OF 1960-61 BUDGET MEETING

In accordance with the provisions of the "Local Budget Law" (ORS 294.305 to 294.415), notice is hereby given that the budget committee of the City of Sandy, Oregon, in compliance with said law, prepared and adopted on March 21, 1960, the budget estimates for the City of Sandy, Oregon, for the ensuing fiscal year July 1, 1960 to June 30, 1961, as set forth in the accompanying schedules I, II, III and IV.
