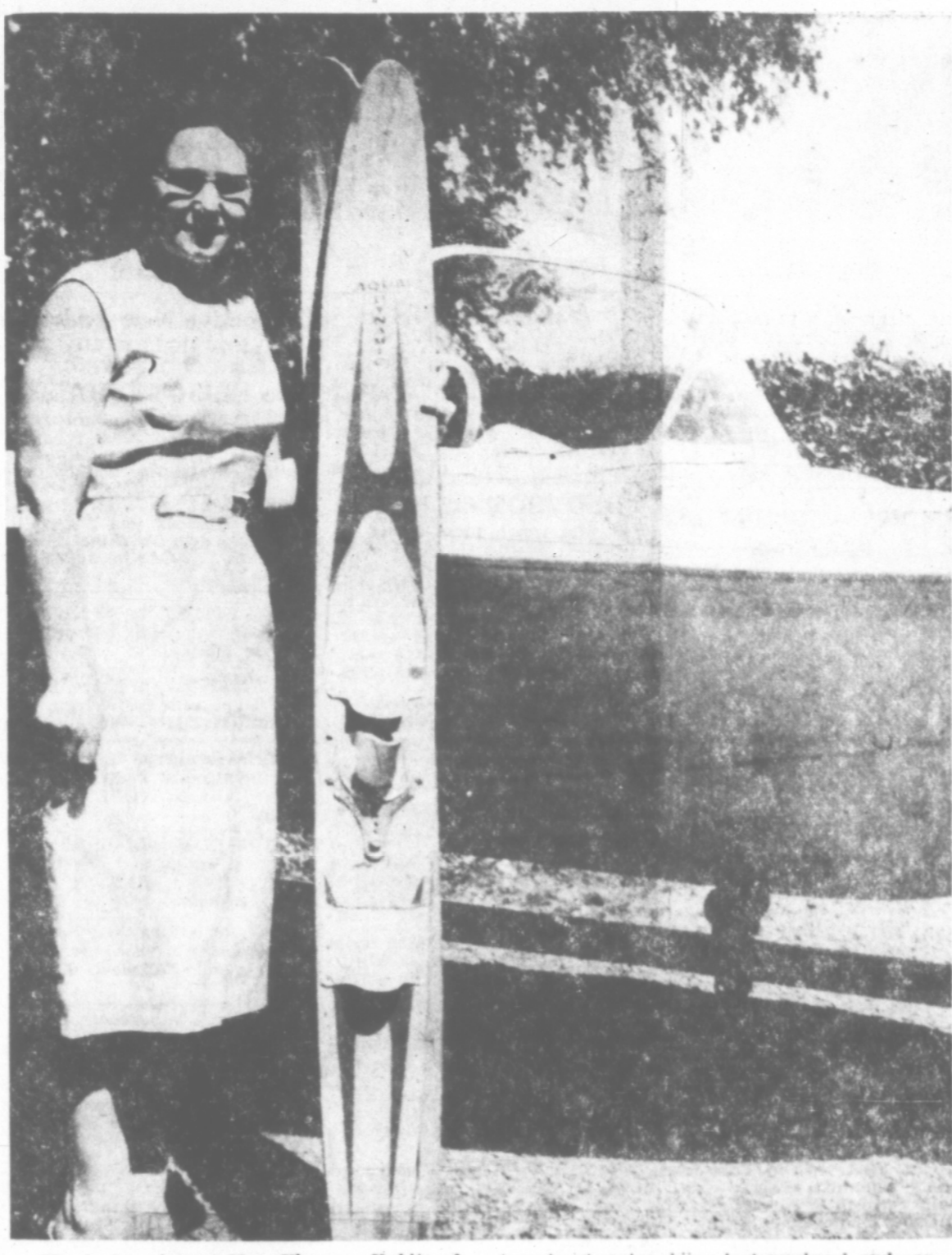

Swimming and Water Skiing Dangers Listed by State Board of Health

Swimming in rivers and public waterways can be more hazardous than it is enjoyable according to Dr. R. H. Wilcox, state health officer, Oregon State Board of Health.

Over 100 Oregonians meet death each year by drowning. Swimming in unsupervised areas, such as rivers, increases the possibility of drowning. The most competent swimmer is at the mercy of the water if he develops cramps when a life-guard is not nearby to come to his rescue. Likewise, obstructions beneath the water surface can trap the swimmer.

Water skiing presents many of the same problems as swimming with a few additional hazards. Only recently a skier was reported drowned in an Oregon river because the pilot did not observe that the skier had fallen. Boating officials recommend that every boat towing a water skier have two occupants - one to pilot the boat and concentrate on steering and the other to observe or help the water skier.

A new law in Oregon, effective Aug. 9, makes it mandatory that every boat towing a water skier have two people in the boat or a suitable curved mirror which enables the pilot to observe the skier.

Another must in water skiing is the wearing of an approved-type life belt or life vest, adequately fastened, that cannot be torn loose by the impact of a fall.

Cancer Memorials Growing Rapidly

An indication of the growing support of the American Cancer Society's memorial program is announced by William B. Feldenheimer, of Portland, president of the society's Oregon division, that memorial gifts to the division during the last fiscal year totalled more than \$38,000.

Memorial gifts received by the local county units or the Oregon division of the American Cancer Society are made not only in remembrance of those who have died of cancer, but frequently are made in the name of living members of the family or friends in honor of birthdays, anniversaries and other important events. These "living memorials" help expand the research and education programs of the society enabling more lives to be saved.

High Growers Of Strawberries Eligible for Club

The Oregon Strawberry Council, which honors the high grower in each county at a dinner meeting in November, announces the change of its 5 Ton club to the Oregon 5-50 Strawberry club.

To qualify for membership a grower must now produce a minimum of 50 tons of berries with a minimum of 5 tons per acre. All producing acreage must be counted.

According to Multnomah county agent J. Fremont Sprowls, it is the hope of the council that the larger strawberry growers will be interested in this program and that high producing small acreage growers will also still be able to meet the requirements of membership. Application blanks are available at the county agents' office.

Purpose of the Oregon 5-50 Strawberry club is to increase economic yields per acre of Oregon strawberries.

By following and comparing cultural practices used by growers producing yields of 5 tons or more, it is hoped that other growers will benefit and produce higher yields.
