New Hunter Law Starts Jan. 1

The hunter safety training law becomes effective Jan. 1, reminds Milt Guymon of the Oregon State Game Commission. Children 18 years of age or older are not required to pass the course if they want to hunt. Also persons 17 years of age and less are not required to show a Certificate of Competency in the safe handling of firearms when purchasing a hunting license. The certificate, however, is necessary when hunting on any land other than their own and must be in their possession. It doesn't make any difference if the child has been issued a previous hunting license; if he is 17 or less and wants to hunt he will have to get this certificate.

Farm Home Serves Area

Although in Corvallis, the Women's Christian Temperance Union Farm Home has ties with Sandy and Clackamas county. Providing a temporary home for children throughout the state who have, through no fault of their own, been left homeless, it has in its keeping some youngsters from Clackamas county.

Howard Berger of Sandy, executive vice-president of the Clackamas County bank, serves as one of the farm's directors.

The 285-acre farm has nine cottages, each staffed with a house mother and an assistant. An average of about 130 boys and girls ranging in age from 5 to 21 are accommodated each year. These children have been left homeless as a result of desertion, divorce, accidents, illness, death or prison sentences.

A staff of trained social workers and a chaplain guide the rehabilitation of the children.

The farm chapel, destroyed by fire of undetermined origin last July, is currently being rebuilt. Donations have been received from clubs, organizations and individuals all over the state.

Main sources of financial support for the home are the Oregon United Appeal, WCTU, state aid for dependent children, and contributions and bequests from various groups and individuals. All donations are tax deductible.
