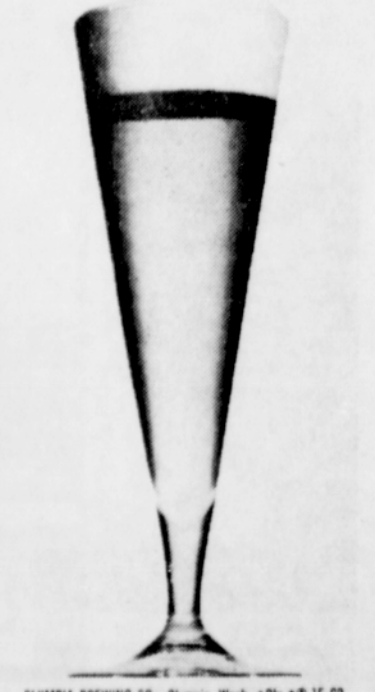
**DANIEL H. LOVE**
