KARL F. GLOS

Karl F. Glos, father of Marshall Glos of Sandy, died last week in a Portland hospital. A prominent Oregon military officer and Portland attorney, he was the central figure in a 1955 State Liquor Control Commission controversy. A 60-year resident of Portland, he retired as a colonel from the U.S. Army after serving in World Wars I and II and the Mexican border campaign. He was a member of national, state and county bar associations, the Society of the Third Infantry Division, Sunnyside Lodge No. 163 of AF&AM, the Scottish Rite, and Al Kader Shrine. He is survived by his widow; sons Karl F., Portland, and Marshall C., Sandy, and four grandchildren.

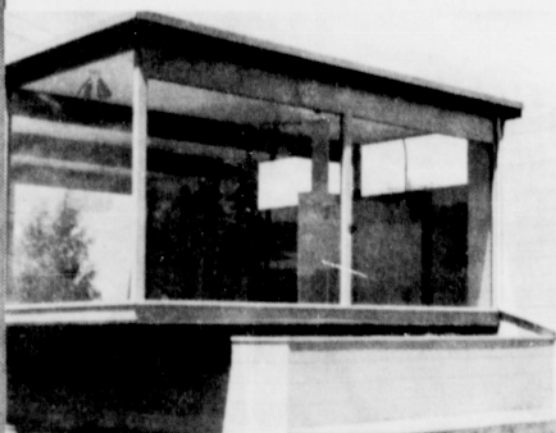

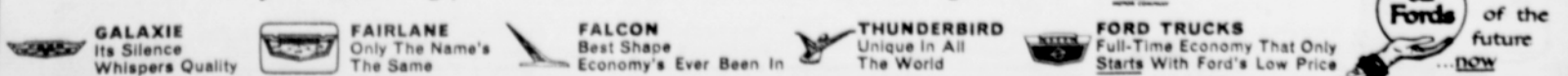
