Sunday Law Draws Fire

A small group of Mt. Hood-
 area businessmen berated the
 proposed Sunday business clo-
 sure at the state legislature
 during a Tuesday night meet-
 ing at Wemme Lions hall.
 Walt Blaisdell, one of those
 present, said the consensus was
 that the bill is discriminatory
 to out-of-Portland business-
 es, especially at resort and
 tourist areas. The bill would
 make for an inconvenience to
 consumers, he added.
 Customers could buy groce-
 ries at a store like his, Blais-
 dell, but couldn't buy on Sun-
 day from another counter in
 his store that might have
 plumbing or garden supplies
 for sale.
