County to Hold Surveyor Exam

Clackamas county is taking applications for a forthcoming civil service examination for the position of chief deputy surveyor for the county. Applications will be accepted until 5 p.m., May 14.

The job will pay from \$500 to \$625 a month and requires a valid registered land surveyor's license. The examination will consist of an evaluation of experience and training.

Applicants must be residents of Oregon, have two years of progressively responsible experience in survey and related work, and graduation from a college or university with major course work in civil or related engineering, although qualifying experience may be substituted for college work.

Application forms are available at the courthouse in Oregon City.

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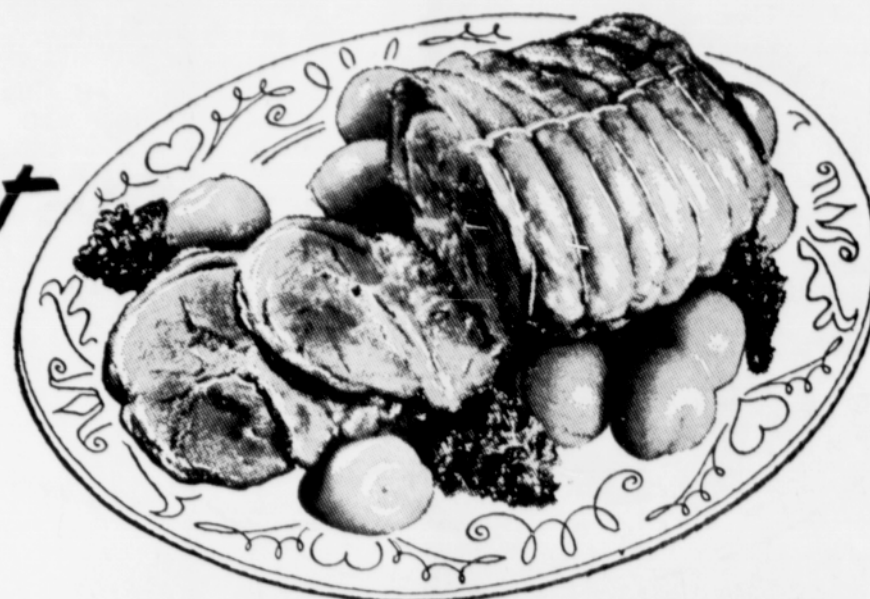
