Every person owning or keeping any dog, having its permanent canine teeth, within Clackamas County, Oregon, shall not later than March 1st of each year or within 30 days after he becomes owner or keeper of such dog, procure from the County Clerk a license for such dog by paying to the County Clerk a license fee, and the fee for such license shall be \$1.50 for each male or spayed bitch dog and \$2.00 for each female dog, if procured prior to March 1st. After March 1st, the fee for such license shall be \$3.00 for each male or spayed bitch, and \$3.50 for each female dog.

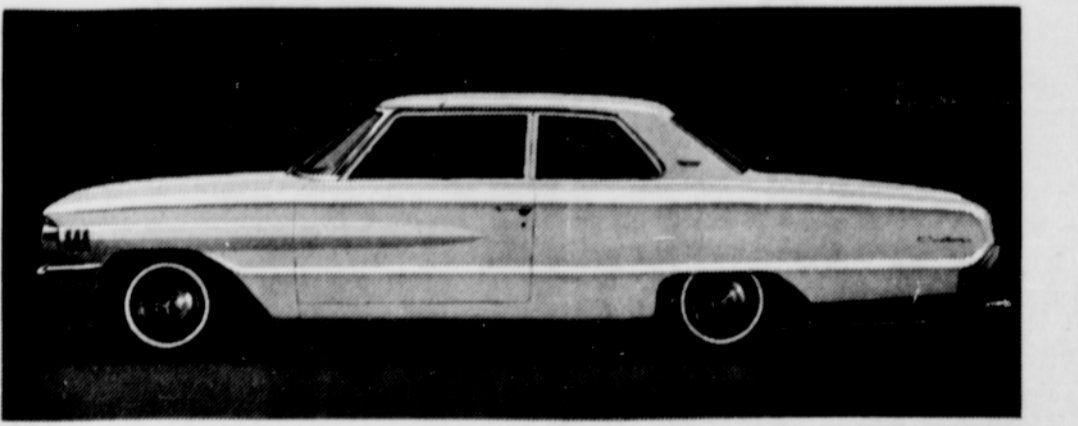
