

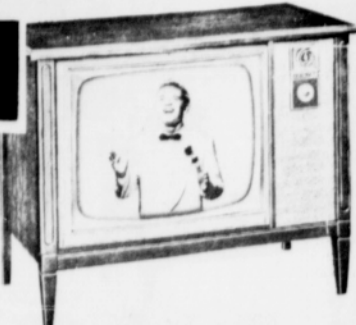

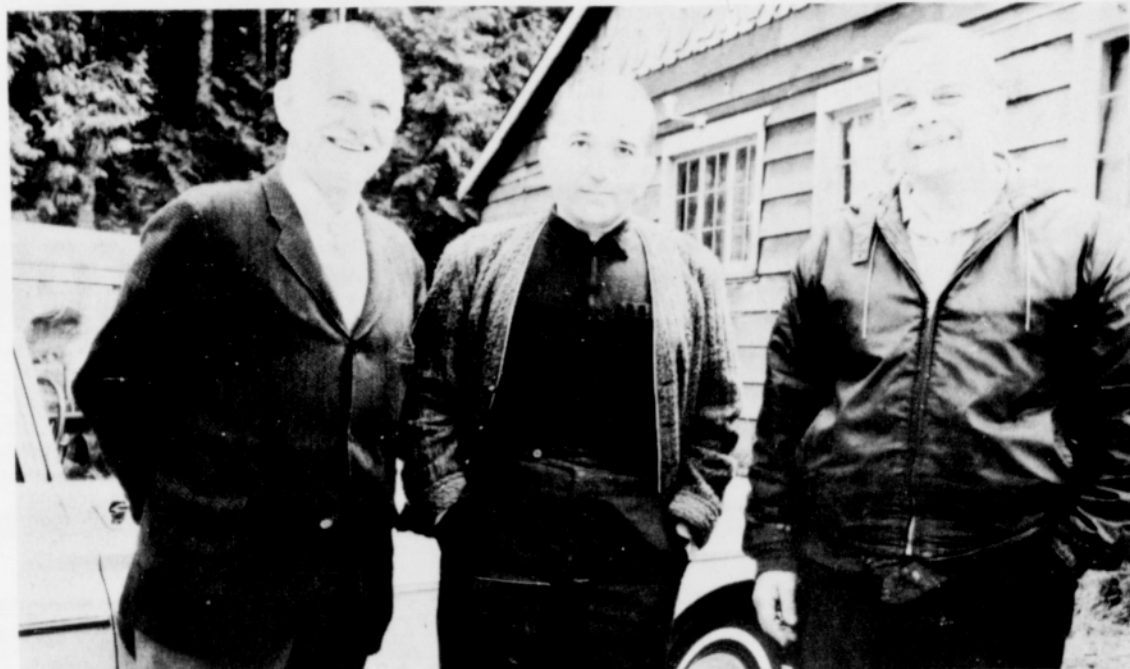

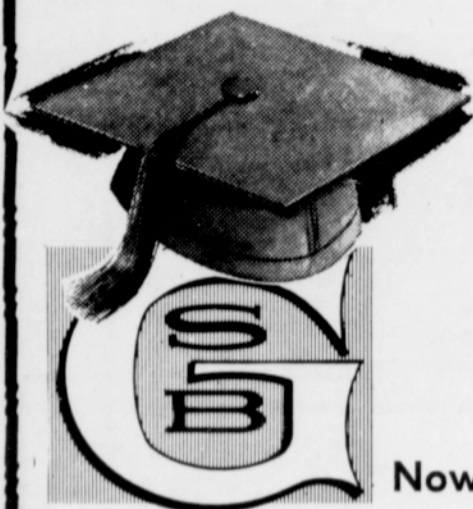


Each Friday performance of the Mark Allen players during the summer season will be a benefit for the Portland Association for Retarded Children. From left to right are

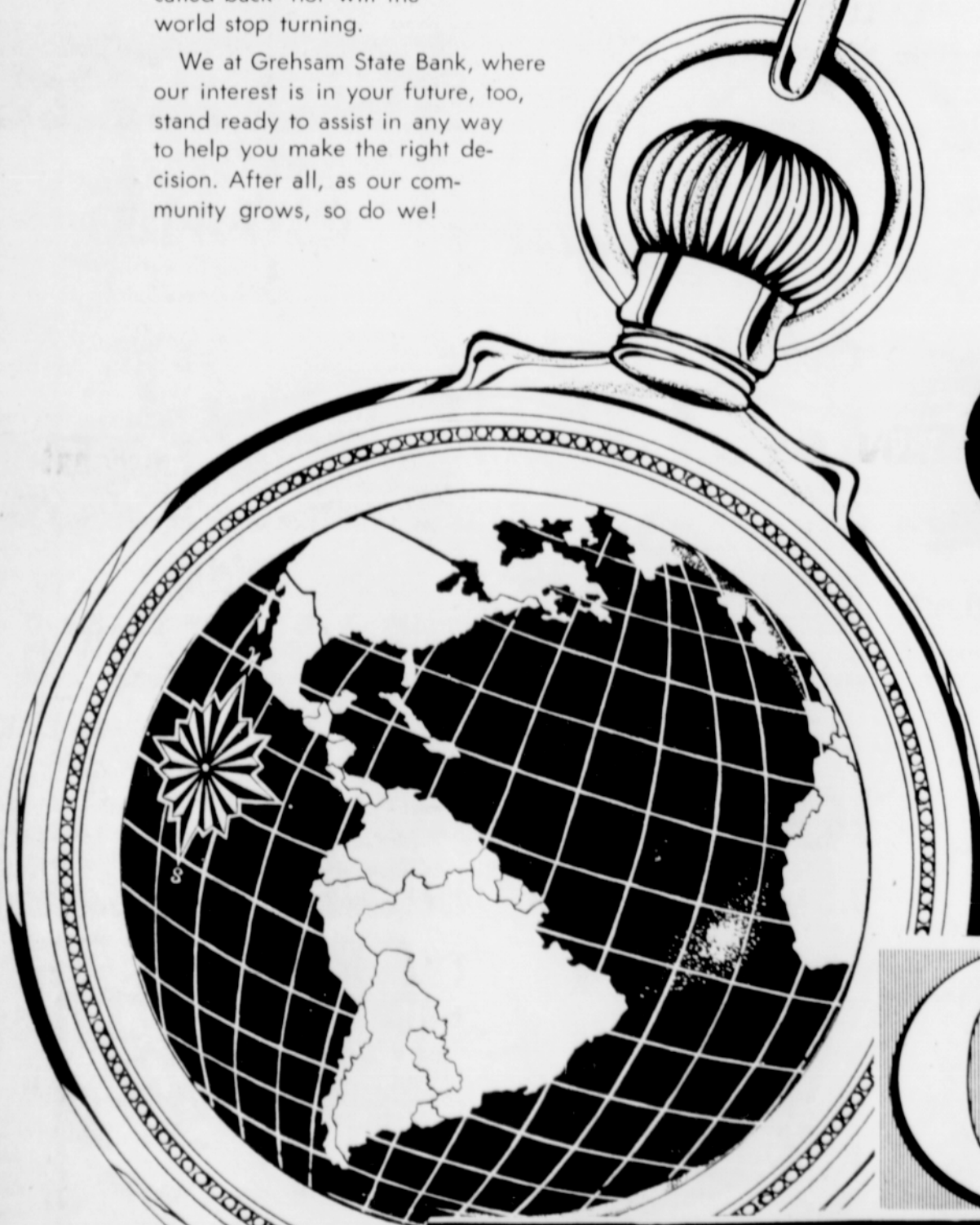

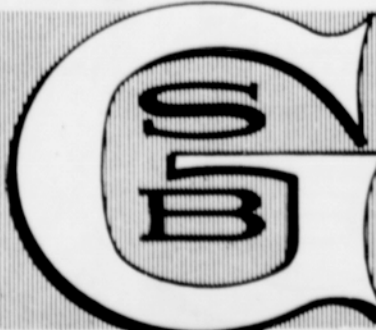
