In the Matter of the Application of COLUMBIA TELEPHONE COMPANY for allocation of exclusively served territory and adjacent unserved territory.
On July 21, 1964, the Public Utility Commission accepted for filing an application of Columbia Telephone Company for an order of the Commission allocating exclusively served and certain adjacent unserved areas as yet unserved by it or any other person, all pursuant to the provisions of ORS Chapter 75. The service areas are specifically designated by description on amended Exhibit "A", which is a map of the areas involved and amended Exhibit "B" and amended Exhibit "C", which are legal descriptions of the areas involved. These exhibits as amended are attached to and made a part of the application which is on file in the office of the Public Utility Commission.
The areas involved include one area which is served exclusively by the Applicant and one adjacent area which is unserved by the Applicant or any other telephone utility. The adjacent areas are located in the eastern part of Multnomah County and in northern Clackamas County. The served and unserved areas as a unit is bounded on the north by the Columbia River, on the east by a line running north to south, one mile west of the East Range Line of Range 6 E, Townships 1N and 18, on the southeast generally by the Bull Run River and on the southwest by the Sandy River to the West Range Line of Range 4E, thence northerly to the Columbia River. The adjacent unserved area covers an area approximately two sections wide on the east and southeast side of the area above generally described.
