

## Lions Discuss Mount Work

Members of the Wemme Lions Club met Wednesday night at their clubhouse with Dr. Roy Carothers, president, presiding.

A lengthy discussion was held on the immediate needs of the mountain area since the flood damage caused last December. Grave concern was shown for the soon-to-arrive spring freshet with its potential of further damage unless the river channels are properly cleared beforehand.

Walt Blazdale made a report on Tuesday night's Sandy-Hoodland Disaster Relief Fund meeting. This group, he stated, felt available monies should be

expended towards clearing the damaged river channels. According to Blazdale, that day Hy Jackson, civil defense director and a corp of engineers had surveyed these channels of particular concern.

The club membership felt this type of project actually was too big for the S-HDRF. Consensus by the group was that federal aid should be asked for. And, this aid should be forthcoming immediately. A suggestion that letters be written to our congressional representatives as well as state reps was made.

Members of the club decided to hold a workday on Saturday, Jan. 16. At this time they will go as a group to help someone located on the mountain with clean-up, etc. of flood damage on that person's property.

Other matters of business by the club included a decision to invite persons outside of the club to their annual banquet

The span is scheduled to be reopened next month. Truman road provides access to the Lolo pass area and some 200 homes. ### Sandy Upends Lancers Here by 70-53 Count

Paced by Franz Meier and Jon Sandstrom the Sandy Pioneers rolled to an easy 70-53 win over Reynolds last Friday night at Sandy. The win gave Sandy a two win and two loss record in Wilco league play.

Meier dunked 23 points in the contest while teammate Sandstrom dropped 19 counters through the bucket as their team coasted to an easy victory. Also scoring in double figures was scrappy guard Dale Phelps with 10 for the evening.

The Pioneers were in complete control of the contest throughout as they jumped to an early lead over the Lancers. By the end of the first quarter Sandy had racked up a 23-3 lead.

Despite a 21 point scoring effort in the second quarter by the outmanned Reynolds quintet, they never came within serious contention. The halftime score ended with the Pioneers holding an 11 point margin, 35-24.

With the start of the second half, the Lancers could do no better and gradually fell farther behind. The third quarter ended with a count of 52-35.

In the final stanza, Coach Nick Robertson allowed his starters to roll a comfortable lead before sending in substitutes to close out the game. The final score being 70-53.

One member of the visiting Reynolds team, Bob Woodward, attended Sandy last year. Woodward led his teammates with a 15 point cause.
