THE FISHERMEN'S GUIDE

With all the talk I've been doing about the approaching fishing season, I think this time I'll mention a few new things that I'm going to try. I can't guarantee any of these ideas yet, because I haven't tried some of them, but I'll pass on the ones that I think stand a chance to catch a few fish.

One that I'm very anxious to try is a number ten gray Mudder with a small split shot clamped about 18 inches in front of it; and retrieved slowly, close to the bottom. I want to try this method over on Badger Lake. It has both good-sized Eastern Brook and Rainbow trout. And from what all I hear, this way is supposed to catch the big ones. Maybe you'll want to try it too.

For you guys that like the hardware, a good friend of mine, Mr. Bittman, who by the way, is also the owner of Bittman's Sporting Goods at Wildwood on Highway 26, has related to me some very successful luck he had in Trillium Lake on Skiny-Miny's.

The gold-colored Super Duper is a good all-around standby for Eastern Brook in the lakes.

After I got nose-deep in my fishing tackle, checking it all over and everything, I decided I was going to have to have a new fishing rod. Not believing what the wife says, of course, which goes something like this--a new fishing rod! What's wrong with all those others? But you know, this is not any worse than all those hats in her closet!

The rod that I'm going to make will be different than the others I have in that I'll make it to dismantle into four sections for carrying in a pack. Oh, and a few other odds and ends, bits and pieces, some new line; got some nice limp monofilament at Bittman's Sporting Goods; a few new lures and a couple of new fly boxes I'm anxious to try. They're referred to as "Daisy Maes" -- circular containers and individual pie-shaped compartments.

And a bunch of the old standby flies to fill it up, like Renegade, Royal Coachman, McGinty Bee, Black Gnat, White Miller, Professor, Silver Doctor, Shoemaker, Rio Grande King, Gray Hackle, Montreal, Parmachenee Belle, Yellow Sally, Red Biss, and the Mosquito. And I think you can find most, or all, of the tackle mentioned at Bittman's Sporting Goods.

Hope to see you out April 24 on the streams, and providing there is not too much snow, May 22 on the high lakes.
