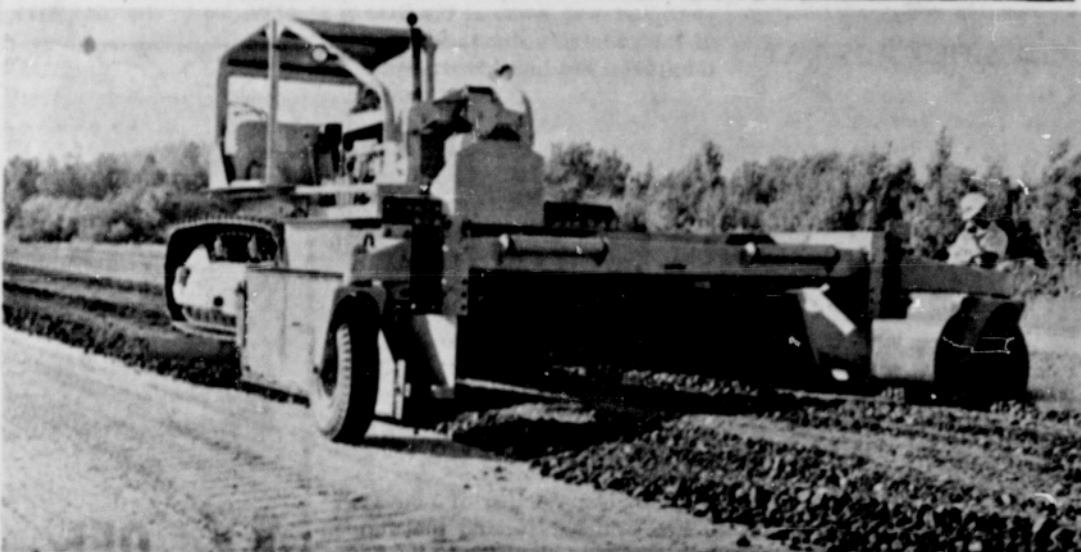

Interest Grows In Mountaineer Festival

Interest is growing in the Mountaineer Festival scheduled in Sandy for the weekend of July 9 - 11 under the sponsorship of the Mt. Hood Jaycees.

A member of the group reported this week that a phone call was received from Seattle, Wash., requesting information and where to sign-up for the go - cart races that will be held here. Following return of the requested information the fellow on the other end of the line closed by saying "we'll be seeing you in a couple of weeks."

The phone call revealed that four or five go - cart enthusiasts were interested in competing. This should add even more interest in this event which is jointly sponsored by the Jaycees and Damascus Rev-N-Ride, Inc. group. Go - cart racing will be held on July 10 and 11.

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HOW REPEAL OF THE EXCISE TAX WILL AFFECT YOUR TELEPHONE BILL

Reduction in the Federal excise tax just approved by Congress and signed into law by the President will result in substantial savings to all telephone users.

The 10 per cent tax on local telephone service and long distance calls—which in 1964 totaled \$2,712,000 for West Coast Telephone Company customers—will be lowered to 3 per cent on January 1, 1966. This is a savings, based on the 1964 figure, of approximately \$1,898,000. A new rate of 2 per cent will apply on January 1, 1967, with a further decrease to 1 per cent on January 1, 1968. The tax will be eliminated entirely the following year.

West Coast Telephone Company pointed out on frequent occasions that the tax was inequitable and should be removed. We are extremely pleased that Congress has voted to reduce the tax, and in three years eliminate it entirely.

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
