

Eagles Claw Pioneers 74-53 In League Tilt

A scrappy Sandy basketball squad went down to defeat 77-53 Tuesday night in their Wilco league opener here against taller Wy'east Golden Eagles. It was the fifth defeat without a victory this season for the hometowners.

Fielding a considerably shorter team the Sandy Pioneers fought it out gamely under the boards throughout the contest. Numerous mistakes on the part of both squads were evident and Sandy's head basketball coach Nick Robertson commented after the game that "numerous mental lapses on the part of his charges were extremely costly."

Leading Sandy scorer for the evening was Brock Jackley who bucketed 16 points Tuesday. For Wy'east Cam Axford dunked 16 points, also, to share in the night's high scoring honors. First bucket for the night was by Wy'east as a short jumper shot by Lynn Lesselyoung was good. Seconds later Jack Scales pumped a free throw through the hoop and then Ron Williams split the net with a long shot to put the Pioneers ahead 3-2. The lead, however was short lived as the Golden Eagles bounced back into the front. Wy'east held a 14-11 lead at the end of the first quarter.

Sandy moved back into the lead 15-14 as Ron Verdoorn hit on a field goal and Brock Jackley scored with a free throw. The score was knotted again at 16-16 on a free throw by Jack Scales followed by another Verdoorn field goal to put the Pioneers ahead 18-17. With about 4 1/2 minutes remaining in the half Scales hit with a long set shot to move Sandy in front for the last time in the tilt 19-18. In the remaining quarter's time the Golden Eagles connected for 12 points while holding Sandy to 4 points. Halftime score being 30-23 in favor of Wy'east.

Coming out for the third stanza the visitors dunked eight points before a Sandy score was made by B. Jackley. The Pioneers, paced by B. Jackley and Dale Phelps matched points briefly with Wy'east players before the Eagles began to increase their already slim lead. As the third quarter came to a close Sandy had slipped back 15 points, trailing 55-40. The Wy'east team continued in their scoring ways as the final quarter got under way stretching their lead even more. Both teams sent in their substitutes in the closing minutes of the game. The final score ended 74-53.

Requesting the permit to build the lodge were Mr. and Mrs. George Smith of Portland. The Smiths formerly operated the Portland Club according to reports.

Included in the lodge would be 39 one and two-bedroom units. Construction is proposed to be in a park-like setting that eventually would add a golf course, alpine lodge and dining facilities.

They would be rental units instead of permanent residents the Smiths announced. The conditional use permit was granted subject to the plans.

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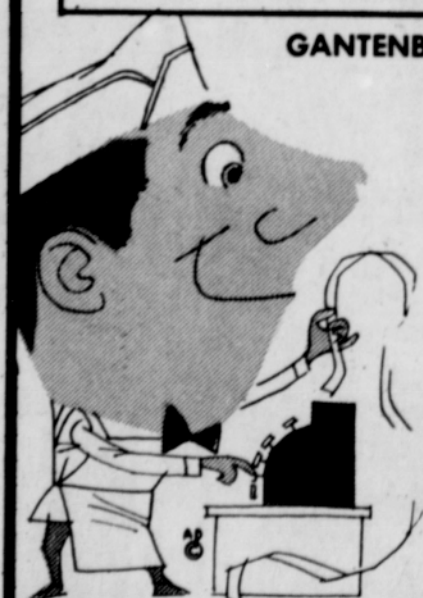
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
