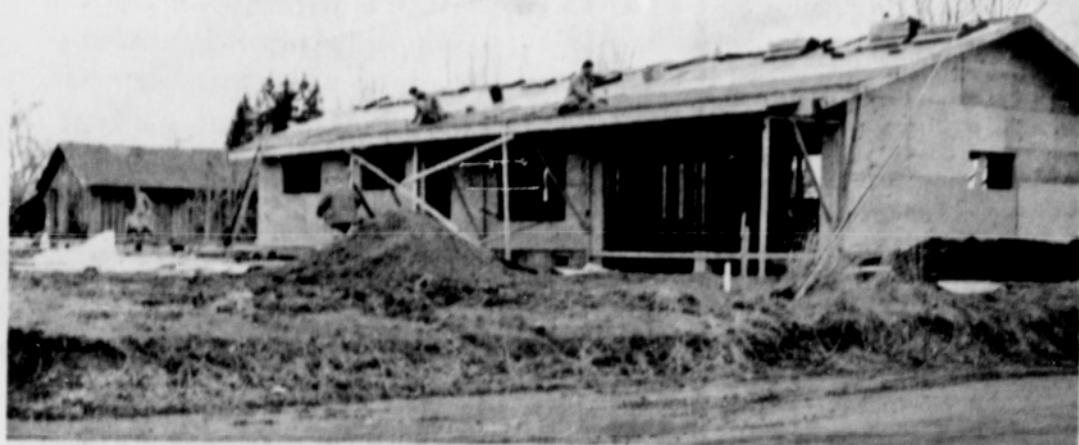

Clackamas River Property Is Purchased for State Park Site

About 861 acres of property located on the Clackamas River near Estacada has been purchased by the State of Oregon. A deed conveying the property from Barney and Helen Lucas to the state "by and through the State Highway Commission" was recorded last Friday in the county clerk's office.

Bordering the river, the property will be converted into a state park according to Darrell Jones, county commissioner. Purchase price of the land was \$255,000.

Owners of the property had originally intended to build a recreation area here it is reported.

It was to include a 9-hole golf course but floods of 1964 and 1965 erased these plans. Lucas presented engineering data he had accumulated on the site and recommended that the area be converted into a state park upon learning that the State Highway Commission was interested in locating a new state park in the metropolitan area.

Miller Family Members Hurt

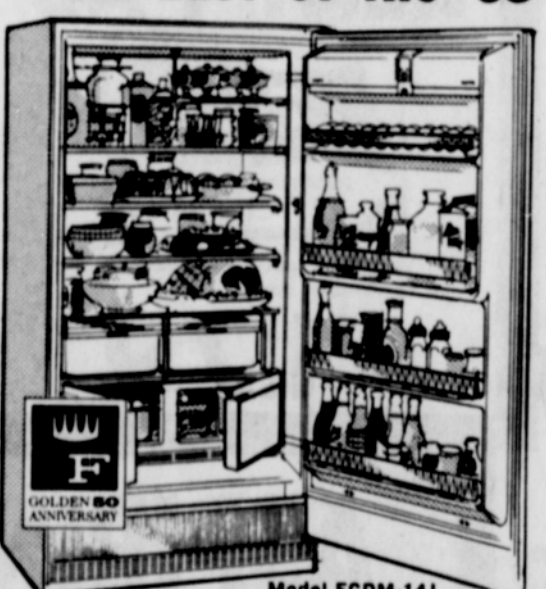

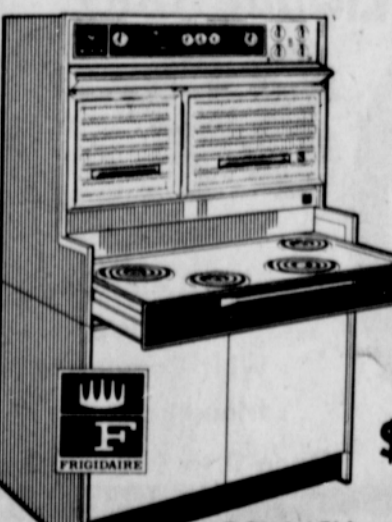
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
