A new welding program beginning this year at Mount Hood

Firwood

Operation Weight Watch was a huge success in Firwood Unit last Tues, Sept. 12. If you see some trim lovely people around town, don't be surprised. Many will be watching calories, but will be eating as much or more than before.

The way foods are prepared make a big difference calorie-wise--for example pot roast (lean) 3 oz. -- 170 calories. Broiled hamburger--3 oz.-- 245 cal. Beef pot pie, 1 1/4 diameter--590 cal. Baked potato, 2-1/2", 90 cal. French Fried potatoes, 10 pieces 155 cal. So you see why correct preparation is important.

Effective weight control and good nutrition go hand in hand. A balanced diet of the four basic foods which are--milk group, meat group, vegetable and fruit group, and bread and cereal groups is suggested. Each of these food groups have a certain part of the body that they nourish. Milk group is called bone savers. Meat group--body repairman; fruit and vegetable group--eye experts and cement makers. Breads and cereal group--body spark plugs.

Get into the habit of good eating, you won't be sorry later. Do you know overweight is associated with diabetes, high blood pressure, hardening of the arteries, heart failure, excessive sweating and even flat feet.

Would you walk 3 or 4 miles for a piece of cake? That's the distance it takes to burn up the cake's calories. All calories count, but its the day's total that's important. Just an extra piece of fudge or a tablespoon of butter (100 cal.) each day for a year will add more than 10 lbs.--250 extra calories each day adds more than 24 lbs. a year.

You're taking all the fun out of eating--is this what you're thinking? Well here's the solution, don't make a clean sweep. If you like pie or cake, take a thinner slice, or maybe omit the frosting on the cake... cut down not OUT.

Snacks are also recommended but the low calorie kind--black coffee, ice tea, carrot sticks, bouillon cubes, tossed salad with low cal. dressing, pickles. Leave out extra high calorie foods as sugar, candy, jam, jelly, gravies, popcorn, pretzels, potato chips, doughnuts, cookies, pies, alcoholic beverages (an Old Fashioned is 166 calories).

We also learned about Diet Fads. Beware of these. Most are very expensive for what you get and do little good. Some even cause heart palpitations and insomnia; another one, Ayls, a Hershey bar has the same formula.

Liquid diets are hard to stick to and have no roughage; another the Mayo Diet--the Mayo Clinic does not claim any of these. So guess it would be better to eat less and be safe. Some artificial sweetener is recommended but don't get carried away, you need some sugar. Exercise is important too. Keeps you toned up and does burn up calories. Walking, climbing stairs, good brisk activities of any kind is good. A good stomach exercise--when you are talking on the phone or any time during the day--suck in your stomach as hard as you can and hold it as long as you can.

Your success in weight control is measured in the years to come. Weight control that becomes a personal habit is less likely to be a personal problem now or five years from now.

Community College will include evening classes in three position arc welding, flat, vertical and overhead, for any interested adults, as part of their occupational extension program.

To be included in the evening adult classes are AD-DC, straight and reverse polarity welding. Electrodes used in the welding programs will be the 6011 series and the low hydrogen 7016 series.

At present, there are two night classes scheduled for Tuesday and Thursday evenings and Arnie Heuchert, director of vocational education, says that if necessary, a greater demand for the classes would be met by opening up to four more additional sections. The classes will be limited to 15 adults each and will cost \$15, which will include rod and rent on a helmet and glasses.

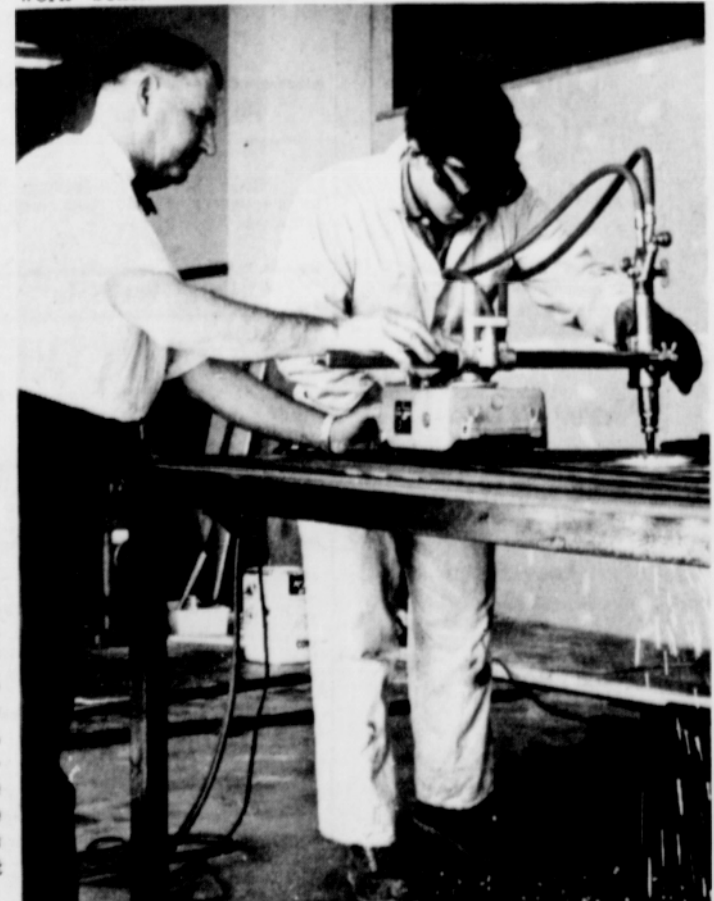
Regular full-time day classes will be open to MHCC students and will include such courses as oxyacetylene welding, arc welding, blueprint reading and sketching, metallurgy, and new developments in inert gas welding said Joe Price, who is in charge of the welding program.

The daytime classes, said Price, will carry 15 students per class on a full time basis and will qualify them to take an entry position in any of the following general areas: Light prefabrication, heavy industry, heavy construction, marine construction, machine shops and automobile repair. The students will be able to go into industry on an accredited apprenticeship basis receiving full credit for the welding knowledge gained in their courses at MHCC.

Registration for the night and day classes is in process now and will continue through next week at the admissions office at the South Campus at Kane and Cochran Roads from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday through Friday and from 7-9 p.m., Monday through Thursday.

The facilities include a bank of 13 new 300 amp AC-DC Miller Welding machines which permit giving all types of arc training. In addition two 300 amp motor-generator type welding machines are available to simulate as near as possible field conditions.

The welding shop, designed and built by Price has 15 masonite type booths equipped with work bench for arc welding
