Pioneers Drop Wilco Opener To Parkrose Broncs, 55-72

Parkrose, playing what their coach Bob Franz termed "our kind of game" trimmed Sandy 72-55 Friday in the opening game in Wilco League play. It was the first loss of the season for coach Nick Robertson's Pioneers, leaving them 3-1 on the year thus far. The Broncs are 2-1.

The game was tied four times and Sandy led through almost the entire first period the first time 1-0 on Bob Flath's foul shot. Later the Bronchos broke a 10-10 stand-off for a 14-10 lead. Two outside jumpers by Ron Williams plus another basket by Ron Verdoorn gave the Pioneers their last edge 16-14, with 0:58 left to play in the first period.

Ron Davies counter fielder brought the Broncs even and a moment later Tom Kraus gave Parkrose a permanent lead, with a lay-in and it was 36-21 at halftime.

Steve Jones's seven straight points broke the game open late in the opening half. It proved a 34-19 edge and Sandy never recovered. Biggest Broncho margin was 70-50 just prior to the finish.
