Firm Acquires Two Operations

Previously approved acquisitions by Electronic Specialty Co. of Bergman Manufacturing Company of San Rafael, and R. L. Smith Engineering, Inc. of Ingleswood, have been consummated, it was announced this week by William H. Burgess, chairman and chief executive officer.

Bergman -- with sales of \$6 million in 1966 -- is the nation's fifth largest producer of lightweight, high strength precision aluminum and magnesium forgings for the air transportation industry. R. L. Smith is a diversified producer of guidance control systems' components and other metal structures. Smith had sales of approximately \$2 million in 1966. The terms of the acquisitions were not disclosed.
