### MHCC Building Ready for Bids

Bids for the construction of a plant service building for Mt. Hood Community College will be received at the office of the East Side Area Education District until 8 p.m., Jan. 11.

This structure is to house all the mechanical equipment required to serve the entire academic complex of the college. There will be two gas-fired boilers, with an oil standby system, and complete air conditioning equipment.

Enough of the work is to be completed by Oct. 1, 1968, to supply service to the vocational technical building and the health and recreation. All work is to be completed by Jan. 1, 1969.

### Firm Bids Low On MHCC Job

Paul B. Emerick Co., Portland, was successful bidder on construction of a vocational-technical shop building for Mt. Hood Community College.

The Emerick firm submitted a low basic bid of \$808,900. Directors of the East Side Area Education District decided to exercise Alternate No. 2, deducting \$20,800 for use of tilt-up concrete walls in place of brick. This will result in a contract price of \$788,100.

Other bidders were: Howard Brewton, Portland, \$809,987 basic less \$19,000 on Alternate 2; Contractors Inc., Portland, \$813,563 basic less \$14,000 on Alternate 2; and R. A. Gray & Co., Tigard, \$827,777 basic less \$8000 on Alternate 2.

Plans call for a single-story, 43,000 - square - foot building providing classroom and shop facilities. It will have a steel roof deck with insulating concrete topping. Site work will include drainage and construction of a small parking area.

Architects are Lutes & Amundson of Springfield.

### Petitions Signed For Annexation

The addition of 500 to 600 acres of land to the city of Gresham in the near future would push the city's population past the 7,000 mark.

Mrs. Arthur Marcus is circulating petitions for an area to the east of Gresham, according to City Manager Bob McWilliams. More than two-thirds of the property owners representing more than two-thirds of the assessed valuation have signed, according to McWilliams. Only a few more signatures are needed.

Mt. Hood Community College, representing 172 acres, annexed to the city in October. Involved in the present annexation petition is land between Section Line and Kane Rds. and U. S. 26 on the south.
