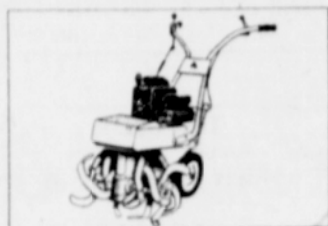

Donald Hattan, Clackamas County Assessor, was the guest speaker at the last Water Board meeting. Sorry to say there were only three people present.

For the past six months the Water Board has been doing everything in their power to get the information to the public. Many people have complained that they did not have enough information on the water board doings to know what was going on.

We have had speakers at every meeting, but one, with all branches of County and other government agencies to help in bringing information to the people.

The turnouts have been three people on the average. There lies the difficulty in getting information to the public.

They wish to complain about the lack of information, but do not wish to take the time to come out to the meetings for the information.

Hattan could not understand the attitude of the public in not paying the bond election. He said water would do more for the community than any other community. It would bring up land values, substantially, and aid in the growth of the area as nothing else could.

New Bulletin Gives Home Freezer Tips

A home freezer, well managed, can save the homemaker's time and energy. It can save trips to the grocery. Foods in season can be purchased in large quantities, frozen, and served the year round.

There are other ways the freezer can help the homemaker serve high quality meals, while cutting down preparation time. But it takes management.

That's the theme of a bulletin currently available from the Oregon State University Cooperative Extension Service. Titled "Prepared and Precooked Foods for the Freezer," Extension bulletin 820 is available at county Extension offices, or by request to the Bulletin Clerk, Oregon State University, Corvallis, 97331.

Since time, energy and money are involved in preserving foods only those that freeze well should be processed, the author of the bulletin explains. Recommendations are given regarding types of food to freeze, containers and wrappings. An illustrated section of the bulletin gives detailed instructions for preparing precooked foods for the freezer.

Marie Tribble, Extension foods and nutrition specialist at OSU, says she receives many calls from homemakers about refreezing thawed foods. EB 820 devotes two pages to answers to this problem, which can arise due to power failure, delay in using food taken from the freezer, or a roundabout return from the grocery where frozen foods were purchased.

Single copies of the bulletin are available without cost to Oregon residents who request them.

Grand prize will be an all-expense trip for two to Las Vegas plus \$50 spending money. There will also be a prize for the man and woman with the most unusual attire.

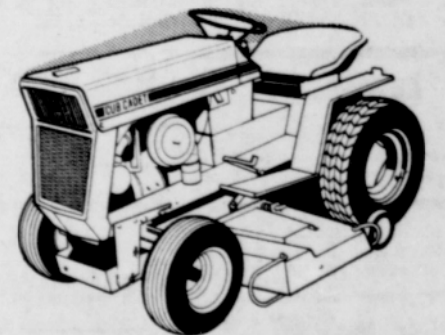

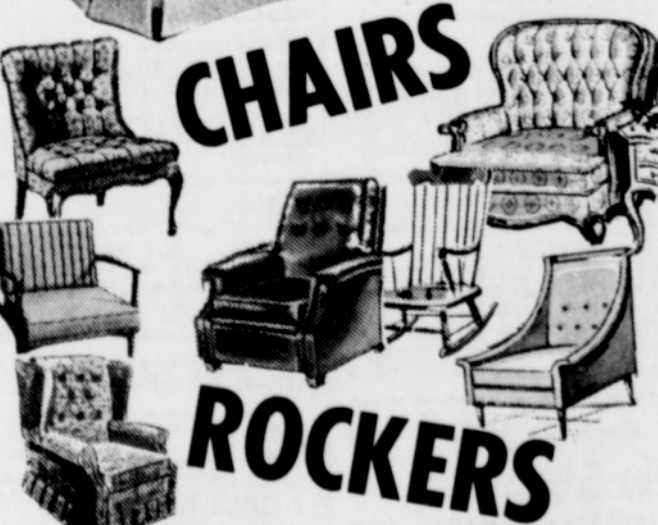

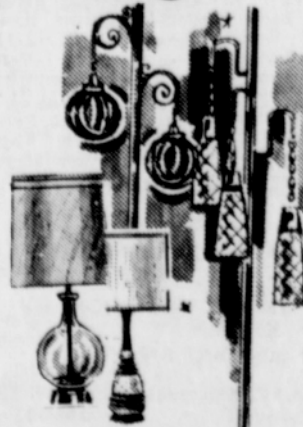

WHO SHOULD HAVE MEASLES VACCINE

Children of one-through-twelve years who have not had regular (7-day) measles or previous measles vaccination. Children who have had either the vaccine or the disease are already immune and need no additional protection. If in doubt, immunize.

WHO SHOULD NOT HAVE MEASLES VACCINE

Children with high fever on the day of the vaccine program.
Children who are allergic to eggs or egg products.
Children who are being treated for cancer, leukemia or tuberculosis.

If a child is under a doctor's care at the time of the clinic, consult him beforehand.
All children must be accompanied by a parent or other responsible adult over 21 years.
