From the River's Edge . . .

It's official, its astronomically correct, and the keepers of our calendar say it happened Wednesday, the 20th day of March. Spring is here. In the woods the pin cherries proclaim it; the first of the larger trees to bloom, the pin cherry outdoes itself with blossoms, but rarely follows through with fruit. Easily identified, even when not in bloom, this tree has the typical reddish cherry bark with its lines of lenticels adding the illusion of horizontal stripings to it. The bark assumes the look of living with the coming of the flowers on every branch tip. The first of the tiny yellow violets show their rich buttery color here and there, often mixed with the purple colored synthris or grouse flower to paint a fairytale miniature on a mossy green canvas. In the dell leading to the river's edge, naturalized Arabis carpets a bank with white.

This Swiss National is really at home here. Wild ginger is busy making new leaves and the hidden flower buds, half buried in leaf mold under the large shiny leaves, are swollen to mature size, soon to bloom

with their pedicular red purple flowers completely unseen except to the curious. If you would see the flower of wild ginger, you must first lift up the ground hugging leaves.
 Spring may be here by the calendar, but all of the birds are not convinced. The Junco's believe it; they are already moving higher into the mountains leaving the local residents in possession of this territory. The Varied Thrushes, though, are still in their winter flocks, making great commotions on the forest floor as they toss the fallen leaves of last fall around, literally plowing them up in places, hunting for food. After one flock of them thoroughly worked over a nearby bank under some maples, the leafy carpet floor was fluffed up to a depth of six inches over the whole area from their labors.
