When we went to the Strawberry Festival in Lebanon recently we visited our good friends, Ruth and Chester Ellis, and I came home loaded with some of Ruth's good recipes.

#### BAKED CHICKEN CASSEROLE

1 6-oz. can or 1-1/2 cups chicken meat cut in small pieces (more meat is good). Combine chicken and juice in a 9" dish with contents of 10-1/2 oz. can condensed cream of chicken soup. Mix in 1 cup partly cooked celery, 2 teaspoons minced onion, 1/2 cup sliced almonds or walnuts, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/4 teaspoon pepper, 1



PLAN A QUICK, easy, kid-pleasin' meal around Oven Easy Burgers and cheese topped French fries. Bake both in the oven, serve with relishes and milk. For dessert, serve ice cream sundaes topped with hot fudge sauce.

Tablespoon lemon juice, 1/3 cup mayonnaise, and 3 hard cooked eggs, sliced thin. Top with 2 cups crushed potato chips. (Note: One small can of mushrooms may be added or substituted for the nuts.) Bake in hot oven, 400 degrees, 15 minutes or until well heated through. Serves 6-8. Turkey may be substituted for chicken. --From the files of Mrs. Chester Ellis, Lebanon, Oregon.

#### LEMON-LIME SALAD

1 3-oz. pkg. lemon jello  
1 3-oz. pkg. lime jello  
Dissolve in 1 pt. hot water and cool

Add 1 No. 2 can (1 lb.) crushed pineapple, 1 can Eagle Brand Sweetened condensed milk, 1 pint cottage cheese, 1 cup salad dressing, 2 Tablespoons horseradish, and 1/2 to 1 cup nut meats. Place in 9" x 13-1/2"

The following recipe has been printed before but I have had requests to repeat it. It is a must for your file.

#### DELICIOUS SALAD

1 small can crushed pineapple  
1/2 cup sugar  
1 cup boiling water  
1/4 to 1/2 cup nuts  
1/2 lb. grated cheddar cheese  
1 3-oz. pkg. orange, lemon, or orange-pineapple jello  
1/2 pt. whipped cream or 1 env. dream whip.

Cook pineapple and sugar together three minutes. Pour over jello which has been dissolved in boiling water. Put in refrigerator until syrupy. Whip with beater, add nuts and cheese. Fold in whipped cream. Pour into mold. Serves 10-12. Very good! --From the files of Mrs. Garlan McCulloch, Sandy, Oregon. (Note: I prefer the smaller amount of nuts in jello salad.)

#### DATE SANDWICH BARS

Cook until thick:

1 cup hot water  
1 cup chopped dates  
1 cup raisins  
(May use all dates.)  
1/2 cup sugar  
1 teaspoon flour

Sift:

1-1/2 cups flour  
1 teaspoon soda  
1/4 teaspoon salt  
Add:  
1-1/4 cups quick oatmeal  
1 cup brown sugar  
1/3 cup shortening or oil  
Add slowly 2 to 3 Tablespoons milk. Mix well and pack one-half of mixture into lightly oiled 9" pan. Put in date and raisin mixture and cover with last half of dough mixture. Bake in 350 degree oven for about 30 minutes. Cut into bars while warm. These are very good, and Mr. Rice's favorite. --From the files of Mrs. Arthur Rice, Seattle, Washington. #### EASY BROWNIES

1/4 cup cold water  
1 egg mixed with 3/4 to 1 cup nut meats  
Pkg. chocolate cake mix. Mix and put into greased 9" x 13" pan. Bake at 350 degrees just until done to touch. Do not overbake. Frost with chocolate frosting. --From the files of Mrs. Chester Ellis, Lebanon, Oregon
