MHCC Offers

Sewing Class

Mt. Hood Community College will offer a class in Basic Bishop in Sandy starting at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, Feb. 18, and continuing each Tuesday evening for 10 weeks.

Tuition for the class, which will be held in Room 17 at Sandy high school, totals \$15. Mrs. Shirley Morgan is the state approved instructor.

Emphasis of the course is on professional sewing techniques taught by the Bishop Method through the construction of an apron, blouse, skirt, and simple dress, all of cotton fabric. Instruction in Basic Bishop technique includes the preparation of fabric, simple measurements and alterations, zipper applications, hems, collars and belts.

This basic course is a prerequisite for all other Bishop Method Sewing courses which include Advanced Dressmaking, General Tailoring, Advanced Tailoring, Making a Basic Pattern, Pattern Adaptation, and Shirts and Slacks.

Registration for the course will be held at the first class meeting on Feb. 18.

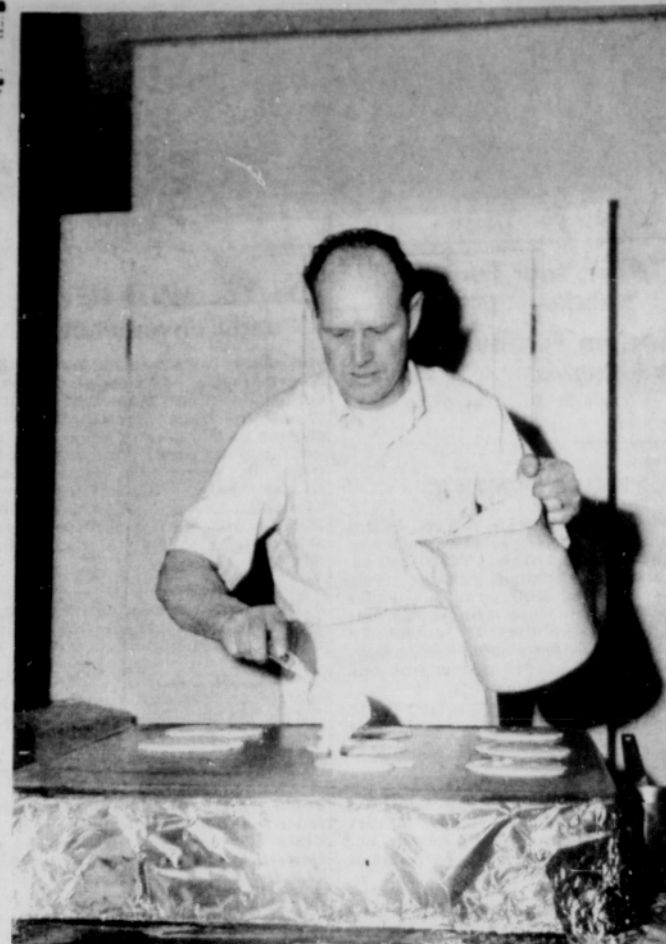
Navy Advances Curtis Neilson
