FROM The RIVER'S EDGE

Nymphs There are four basic kinds of fly fishing; dry fly, wet fly, nymph, and streamer fly. These have areas of overlapping in technique. For instance the dead drift technique in nymphing is borrowed directly from the methods of the dry fly man. The hand twist retrieve is effective in nymph, wet fly, and streamer fly fishing, although it is basically a wet fly technique. It is in the construction and design of the fly itself that the four kinds are readily separated and apparent. In wet fly, nymph, and dry fly we imitate various stages of insect life. In streamer flies we are imitating small fish.

For early season fly fishing, nymphing is usually the most productive. At this time of the year it is a bottom hugging procedure as it is at the bottom where all the nymphs will be found. Nymphs comprise the lions share of a trout's diet in the spring, so they too will be bottom hugging and more than reluctant to search for their food in the barren upper water. Three insect families comprise the bulk of the stream bottom nymphs that are imitated by anglers. These are the Mayfly family, Caddis family and Stonefly family. As a rule, some stonefly nymphs are both the largest and most active of the nymphs and are the best ones to imitate in the early season. The Deschutes Salmon fly is probably the best known Stonefly in Oregon. There are many other species of Stonefly in our streams, all but a couple smaller than the Deschutes Stone.

An imitation of the larger Stonefly nymphs that has been very successful for me is one of Poly Rosborough's creations called "Casual Dress". It is a dark, grey bodied affair with a muskrat fur collar and tail. The body itself is muskrat fur clipped and spun onto thread. This is a large nymph and on a number six hook, scored well for me last opening day.

In addition to this impressionistic tie in size 6 and 10, I like to use the exact imitation of both the orange and yellow Stonefly nymphs. These are best on size 10. They have the colored silk body, ribbed with black thread, clipped feather wing cases, and herl legs. Worked very slowly, the action and appearance of these imitations are real enough to overcome the suspicions of even a Cagy old Brown trout.

As the season progresses and hatches commence, a larger variety of nymphs become

available to the trout. Just before any hatch appears on top of the water, considerable activity has occurred below the surface. There is a gradual rising of the nymphs (usually more of a pupae than a nymph at this stage, but still very nymphlike in appearance) from the stream bottom to the surface. It is during this ascent that many are taken by the trout. As this ascent is very slow and often is in strong currents, many of the nymphs are carried considerable distances underwater before the surface is reached. This is the time to be dead drifting nymph patterns. This is not easy fishing as drag is as critical here as in dry fly fishing, and the nymph being submerged you cannot so easily detect your drag. The fish take on a slack line naturally during a dead drift, so detection of the strike is an art that must be acquired by practice and observation.

Most of the nymphs in this situation would be Mayfly nymphs, of which there are a myriad number of species. However, they fit into two general categories and you need not have an enormous selection of them to be successful. Usually 12 or 14 hook size, my most successful Mayfly nymph is primarily grey with black thread ribbing, the usual clipped feather wing cases, and hackle whisks for the legs. These are sombre creatures for the most part, so subdued dull colors are preferred. A basic brown nymph as well as a lighter tan one should also be in every collection.

If you become a serious nymph fisherman, you will undoubtedly go in for the more exact imitations of the various species. Most stores offer a meager selection, so you will be faced with two alternatives; either tie them yourself or scour all the tackle house catalogues you can find and send away for them.

Most of the Caddis fly nymphs build a case of sticks, grass, pebbles, or sand around themselves and carry this around with them wherever they go. Trout eat these, cases and all. I have cleaned trout whose stomachs were bulged with empty caddis cases from which they had digested the larva inside. Although the fat, grublike nymph inside the case is a creature most trout never see outside of its case, still an imitation of this larva often works well. The body color may run from white through dirty grey into the yellows and oranges. Some are even green. All have black legs and head. It is a simple proposition to make your own imitations of these. Tie a chenille body in the color desired, add six short legs of herl, and tie off with a bulky black head. The light grey bodied and the pale yellow bodied imitations of these Caddis nymphs have served me best over the years.

Although nymphing is the first of the fly fishing disciplines we have discussed in connection with this seasons fishing, it is the newest. A few nymphs have always been carried by wet fly fishermen to be used occasionally. The concept of an entire fishing method based on nymphs is a
