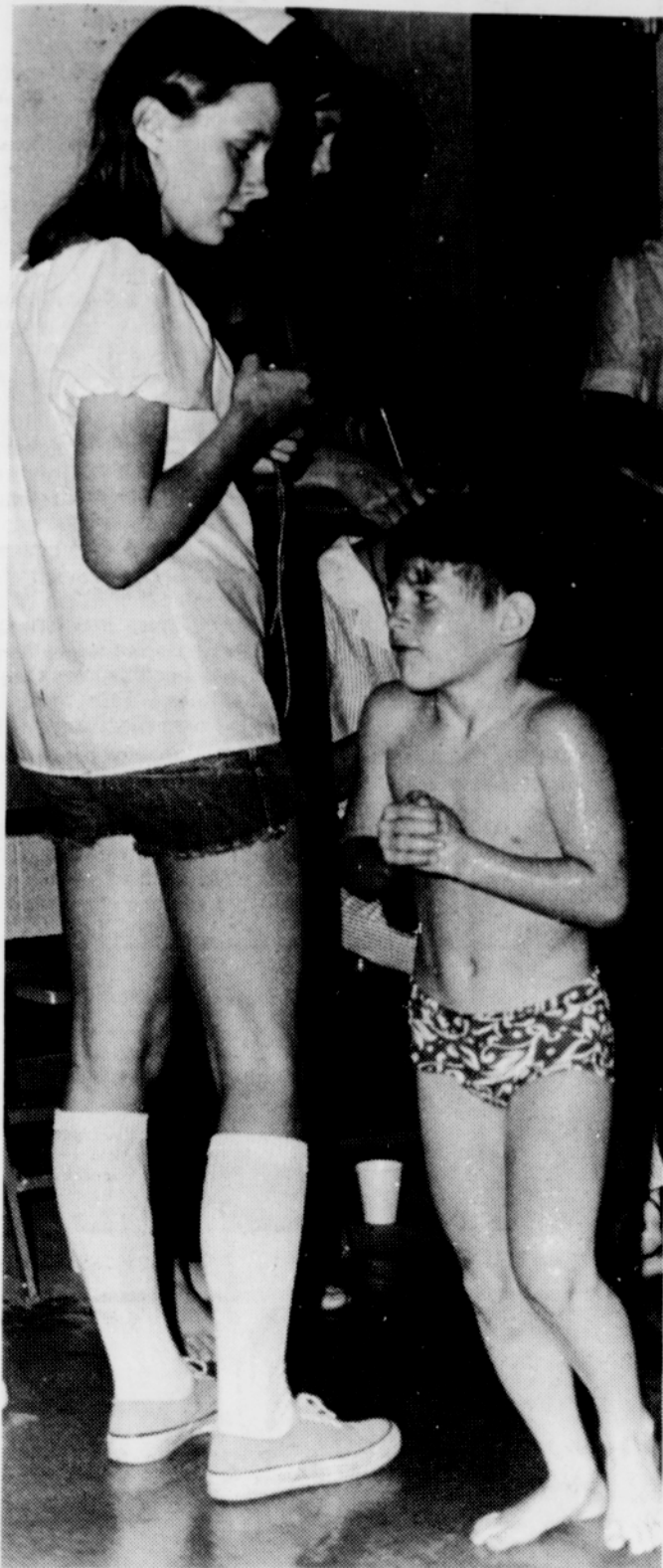


Blue Marlin swim meet termed success

The first annual Blue Marlin Aquatic Club swim meet Saturday was termed a success with over 300 swimmers competing.

Swim team coach, Jim Anstine, stated that the meet which pulled in swimmers from all over the Northwest was the result of a lot of hard work by his swimmers and the adult supporters of the club.

The meet ran all day and there were around 1,200 total swimming entries with awards going to the top six finishers in each event. No team scores were kept.

Teams participating were Sandy, Canby, Kelso, Lake Oswego, Medford, Reynolds, Parkrose, Northeast YMCA, Neighborhood House, Longview YMCA, John R. Leach YMCA and Eastmont Aquanauts.

BMAC Parent Club had over 40 volunteers helping officiate at the meet while the Sandy-Hoodland Jaycees served refreshments to the swimmers.

The Sandy team had 50 swimmers entered and were able to keep many of the first place ribbons at Sandy.

There was a large crowd of parents in attendance at the meet filling up the viewing bleachers while the swimmers were lined around the pool and in the grade school gym.

"Overall this meet was a learning one for both myself and my swimmers and the parents who helped us," said coach Anstine. "Next year we will be able to improve in some areas to help the meet run smoother," he said.

Toddler swim class offered at Sandy pool

Water baby classes will be held from 6:15 to 6:45 p.m. Monday through Friday at the Sandy swimming pool starting June 14.

The session will include 10 lessons and will run until June 25. Two more sessions will be available this summer depending on demand.

The ages range from one month through the 3rd year or the 4th birthday. The mothers or fathers (or responsible person) of the babies to three years must be in the water to care for their child. A parent should be in the area of the pool to watch their 3 year old.

The place is Sandy pools small wading pool.

Sign up time is Saturday, June 12 at the Sandy Pool. The time will be 10 - 12 a.m. for those living in the district, and 12-2 p.m. for those out of the district.

The cost is the same as for other lessons, \$3.50 for those in the district, and \$4 for those

outside the Sandy district.

If you can not come to the pool on Saturday June 12, please call the Sandy pool on that day and ask that your child be signed up for the class.

Jess Samsel took top honors for the team with a second in the 50 yard breaststroke, and fourth place in the 100 yard breaststroke and the 100 yard free style.

Other placers for the Sandy team were Lori Anderson third place in the backstroke, Ron Hewitt tied for third in the 100 yard free style, Steve Lindsey took third in the 100 yard backstroke and fifth in the butterfly and the medley relay team took fourth and the free style relay took fifth.

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
