Coupons collected for funds

The Kidney Association of Oregon has received permission to continue its statewide collection and redemption of Betty Crocker coupons for an additional 18 months, to provide funds to the KAO program for Oregonians who are victims of kidney failure.

Between June 1, 1970, and Dec. 31, 1971, individual Oregonians, schools, churches, veterans groups, fraternal organizations, youth groups and others collected more than 10½ million coupon points, which KAO redeemed for 19 artificial kidney machines valued at \$52,752.

The announcement of the extension came from Mrs. Marian Anderson, Kidney Association of Oregon Betty Crocker coupon drive statewide chairman, who, together with volunteer chairmen in each Oregon county, spearheaded the highly successful campaign.

Mrs. Anderson said, "The extension of the drive is wonderful news. This will enable us to continue to provide the financial help so vitally needed by KAO." She asked the public "To continue to collect coupons and turn them over to county chairmen." She explained that as county chairmen collect the coupons they will be forwarded to her and then shipped to General Mills for redemption.

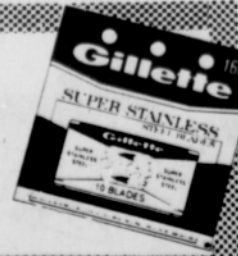
