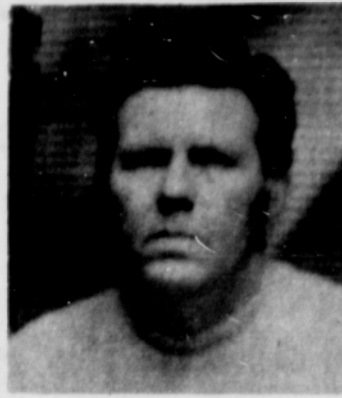
The play, which was written by Pat Drapela, a Montessori teacher, will be directed by the Milwaukee playwright.

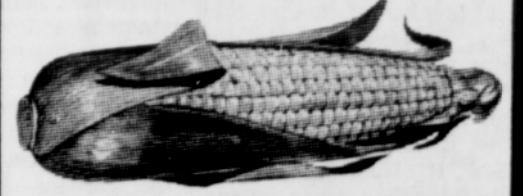

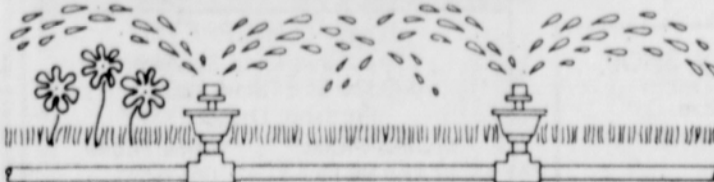
