## Greenway meets opposition

The Troutdale planning commission has promised homeowners they will meet soon to iron out problems in the developing of greenways in the city's residential district.

Commission members voted to meet at the first opportunity with the city council, city attorney and the developer of two subdivisions on SW 14 and 15th Streets. Homeowners in the area abutting the first portion of the city's greenway-pedestrian system charge that their developer, Davies Homes, has no intention of improving the greenway in back of their homes.

Others have protested they were unaware of the greenway when they purchased their homes.

Chairman Robert Allegre has described the situation as "a legal matter since homeowner's titles fail to show common ownership in the greenway on SW 14th." It has been the city's intention that homeowners should own the greenway space in common once it was improved with grass, plantings and pathways by the developer.

In other matters at last week's meeting the commission voted to amend an agreement for gravel mining on Troutdale Road giving applicant Franz Drinker the right to sell surplus topsoil

Both girls are members of the Beaverton Composite Squadron and attend Gresham High School.

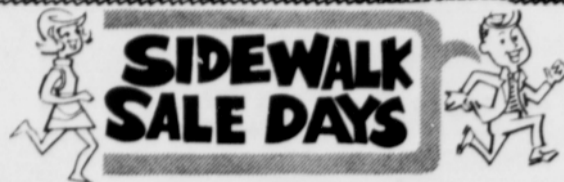
