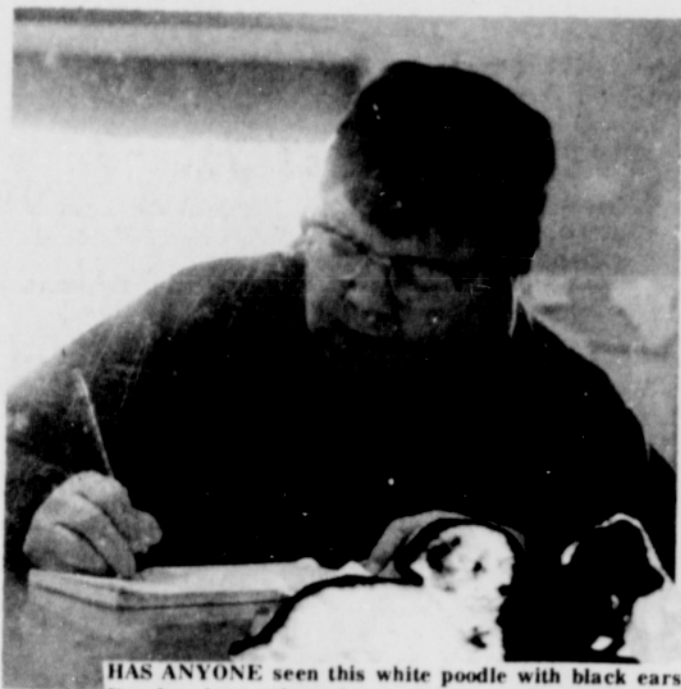

General phone users buck on rate increase

Representatives of the General Telephone Rate Payer Assn. presented testimony at a PUC hearing in Beaverton last week opposing any rate increase.

The Rate Payers Assn. is composed of persons served by General in the Gresham-East County area who believe that not only should a requested rate increase be denied, but that instead rates should be cut.

A petition opposing any increase was read into the record by Mrs. Elizabeth Giles. It cited these reasons:

1. One-third higher rates than the Bell system charges in areas contiguous to General.
2. Consistently poor service going back to 1964 when General purchased West Coast Telephone.
3. Hidden toll charges in basic service rate supposedly eliminated when General took over.
4. Advertisements stating

service has been improved and charges are in line with the Bell

System's rate structure.

subscribers are happy because they "pay such low rates for

efficient service."

6. Frequent outages and noise on telephone lines.

General is asking a \$2.5 million rate increase for its Oregon properties.

Also a point of criticism was the fact that East Multnomah county subscribers must pay toll charges to call Beaverton, Hillsboro, Oregon City, Milwaukie etc.

No decision was announced at the PUC hearing since it was devoted to taking testimony. A decision is likely, however, in the near future.

Mt. Hood tuition rates up

It's going to cost more to attend Mt. Hood Community College next year.

The College board last week approved tuition hikes which will increase the cost from \$85 per quarter to \$90 for A Full-Time in-district student.

A student attending less than full time will pay \$8 per credit hour, compared to \$7 at

present. Over 17 hours, a Full-time student will pay \$4 per credit hour.

Out-of-district and out-of-state students will continue to pay \$10 and \$20, respectively, per credit hour. They also will pay half price over 17 hours.

The increases were dictated by continuing inflation and by uncertainties as to just what

the legislature will do relative school financing.
